

After this was split off, it was carried as a separate piece on the auditor's duplicate until 1874 when it was added to 1.75 ac. that John Bigham also owned in OL 76. From that point it has been called OL 76. But when OL 76 was sold it only contained 1.75 ac. instead of 2. ac. Therefore, it is my opinion that OL 77 was never sold, and now remains to the heirs of John G. Bigham or Nancy Bigham.
