







This parcel came from 3 separate original parcels, all split from A.M. Burkey (85/224)

- .72 deeded to Harold T. Blum in 1938 107/500 out of which he sold .44 to Marjorie Hummel in 1938 108/3, leaving a balance of .28 ac which was combined with two other parcels that he sold to Adrian Nigh in 1957 135/496 (2.75 ac)
  
- .36 deeded to Harold T. Blum in 1938 90/492 (which was split from a .72 ac parcel owned by E.N. Troyer 106/392) and combined with two other parcels when he sold to Adrian Nigh in 1957 135/496 (2.75 ac)
  
- 2.13 deeded to Maimie T. Blum in 1937 107/54 and later sold to Harold T. Blum in 1937 107/170, which was combined with two other parcels when he sold to Adrian Nigh in 1957 135/496 (2.75 ac.)
