 Congress passed on the first day of June 1796, entitled  
 an act regulating the grants of lands appropriated for  
 Military services and for the Society of the United

 the second day of March 1799 on the eleventh day of  
 February and first day of March 1800 and on the third  
 day of March 1803 &c. There is granted unto John Baptiste Viscount  
 de Lomague, who was a Major in Armand's Legion, four  
 certain Tracts of land estimated to contain each one hundred  
 acres, being Lots numbered Nineteen, Twenty Twenty one &
