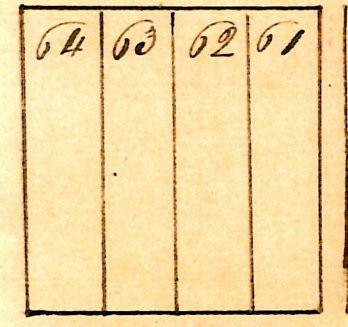
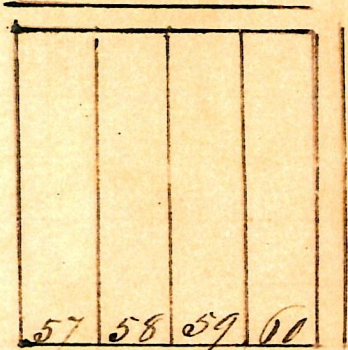


Plan of the Town of Lima situated in Adams County State of Ohio laid off by Moses Newell on the South West Quarter of Section Thirteen Range Six Township nine of Lands offered for sale at Xeniaville all including but-  
 ting on broad way except Lots No 12, 29, 32 & 69. Which are three perches in front and seven perches in length are three perches in front & ten perches in length on lots butting on Common Street and three per-  
 ches in front and twelve perches in length four lots in each block on alley between each block except when there is a street broad way is four perches wide running due East and West Common Street is four perches wide and running due North and South North Street is three perches wide and running due East and West South Street is three perches wide and running due East and West East Street is three perches wide and running due East North and South West Street is three perches wide and running due North and South all alley and one perch wide the said Town contains eighty lots one half is given as a donation to the County at the disposal of the Commissioners for the purpose of erecting the public buildings beginning at Lot one and taking every odd number throughout the Town provided the seat of Justice shall be established at said Town of Lima also on the same provisions a certain piece of Lands is donated for the use of a school house meeting house and burying ground for the use of said Town Situate North of Lots No 41, 42, 43 & 44 twelve rods square adjoining an alley between said Lots and the above described piece of Land the public ground in the Center of said Town ten perches each way - Moses Newell
