

Description 0.0115 acre parcel – (A)

Being a part of the Village of Millersburg, Lot 42, First Quarter, Hardy Township, T-9 N, R-7 W, Holmes County, Ohio, also known as a part of a 20 foot alley aka Diamond Alley, to be vacated.

Described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set on the south line of Sill Street marking the northeast corner of Lot 7 of Pleasant View Glass Plant Addition, Block 7 (Plat vol. 1 page 357-362) the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

thence with the following FOUR (4) COURSES:

- 1) N 89 degrees 56' 40" E 10.00 feet along the south line of Sill Street to an iron pin set;
- 2) S 00 degrees 48' 36" W 50.00 feet along the centerline of said Diamond Alley to an iron pin set;
- 3) S 89 degrees 56' 40" W 10.00 feet to a point marking the southeast corner of said Lot 7, witnessed by a 5/8 inch rebar found S 66 degrees 22' 52" W 0.53 feet;
- 4) N 00 degrees 48' 36" E 50.00 feet along the east line of said Lot 7 and along Richard S. Bernard and Dixie M. Bernard fka Dixie M. Akers' (O.R. 250 page 2279 – PN 0700722000) east line to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

This parcel contains 0.0115 acres, but subject to all highways and easements of record. To go to adjoiner.

All iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebars with a plastic identification cap marked "Baker Surveying LLC".
