surtain that the line A E was right as  
there was no established corner at A.  
The line B, C, D, & E is to remain a  
permanent line, but E, A, B is subject to  
be change when the section is lawfully  
sub-divided — Chain carriers William  
Bennet & Samuel Shrimplin.  
The amount of land may be increased  
or diminished by the sub-division of the  
section, but nevertheless the parties must  
stand to it just the same as if no change was  
made in the line E, A, B  
surveyed June 28<sup>th</sup> 1861
