

On the 26th day of June I proceed to establish said corner in the legal manner namely by commencing at A and running a line and chaining through to C and then setting the corner half that distance on the or a straight line between these two points and after the stake was placed at B it was agreed to be satisfactory to all present and they planted a stone there putting a cross upon it I then run the line north from this established corner and drove a stake at E thus establishing the line between these two points I then run a line from B to F a corner previously established and established the line B F

The stumps of the witness trees are standing at A one of the trees is standing at C the other is entirely gone there is an established corner at D when one of the witness trees is still standing though much decayed I measured the line DC to test the line AC and found it to come out equal in length. Variation of needle 2 1/2°

Frank Barber and Wm Lizer John McKee Mr Summers & young Samuel Prokes were present when the corner stone was planted
