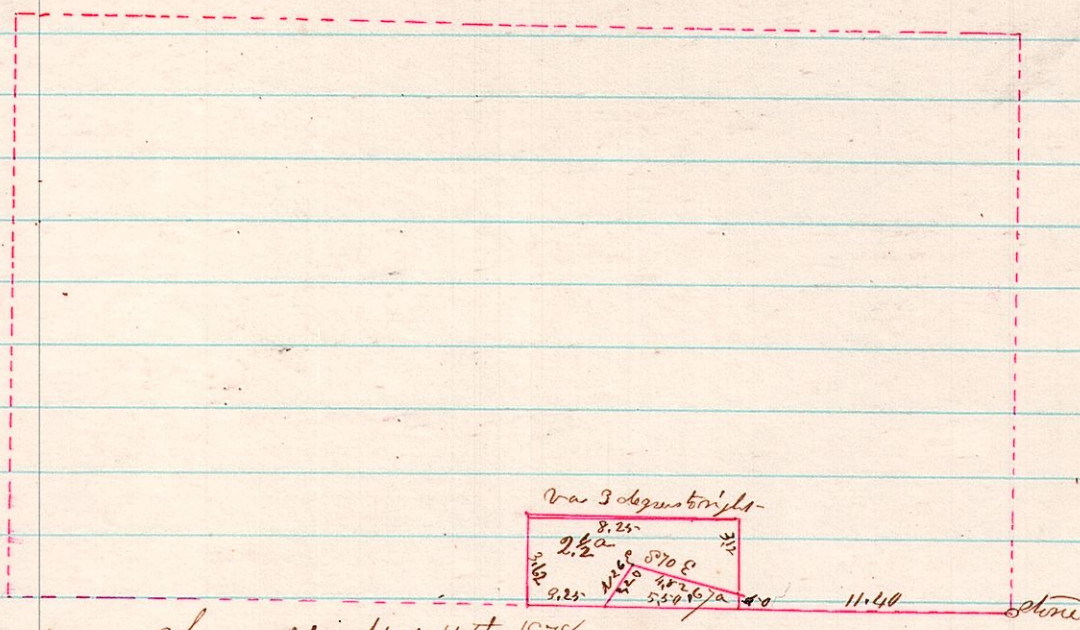


5-9 3rd A Survey made for Eli E. Truyn of 3 acre piece in the South part of Lot 19 in 3rd Tp. 7th R of Range 5

To You are hereby notified that a survey will be made and testimony taken by J. B. Balhoun the county surveyor on the 18th day of April A.D. 1878 between the hours 7 AM & 7 PM and continued from day to day until finished in Lot 19 4th Tp Township 9 of Range 9 for the purpose of establishing the line & corners at the ends thereof between Adaman Smith & Mrs J. Breen & Widows land Elijah Adaman Smith

Given Under the 25th day of March 1878 & served a written copy of the above notice on Mrs J. Breen George Royal & Christ Greiner & A. Sutter Adaman Smith

William Porcell Being duly sworn says to the best of his knowledge & remembrance this place (pointing to the place by some stone) is where Samuel Robinson placed a corner it being the quarter corner on the North line of Section 1 7th R 9

Sworn to and subscribed in my presence this 18th day of April A.D. 1878 J. B. Balhoun County Surveyor

On the 18th day of April I proceeded to establish corners at A.B.C.D. & E and run the line between B.C. being guided by the above testimony field notes of S. Robinson & others according to laws the following being the bearing taken at stake W.O. 81 1/2 S 31 1/4 W 42.2 & W.O. 24 S 87 1/4 E 36 ft at B. stone corner on bearings taken at stump of old tree found & new ones taken Sun 14 1/2 N 13 1/4 W 19.2 & W.O. 21 S 28 W 53 1/2 ft at D. original chestnut gone B.C. decayed & E stone corner Geo. Beckler John Baker & John Tratts were sworn and acted as chairman and flagman I certify the plat below to be correct as surveyed April 11th 1878
