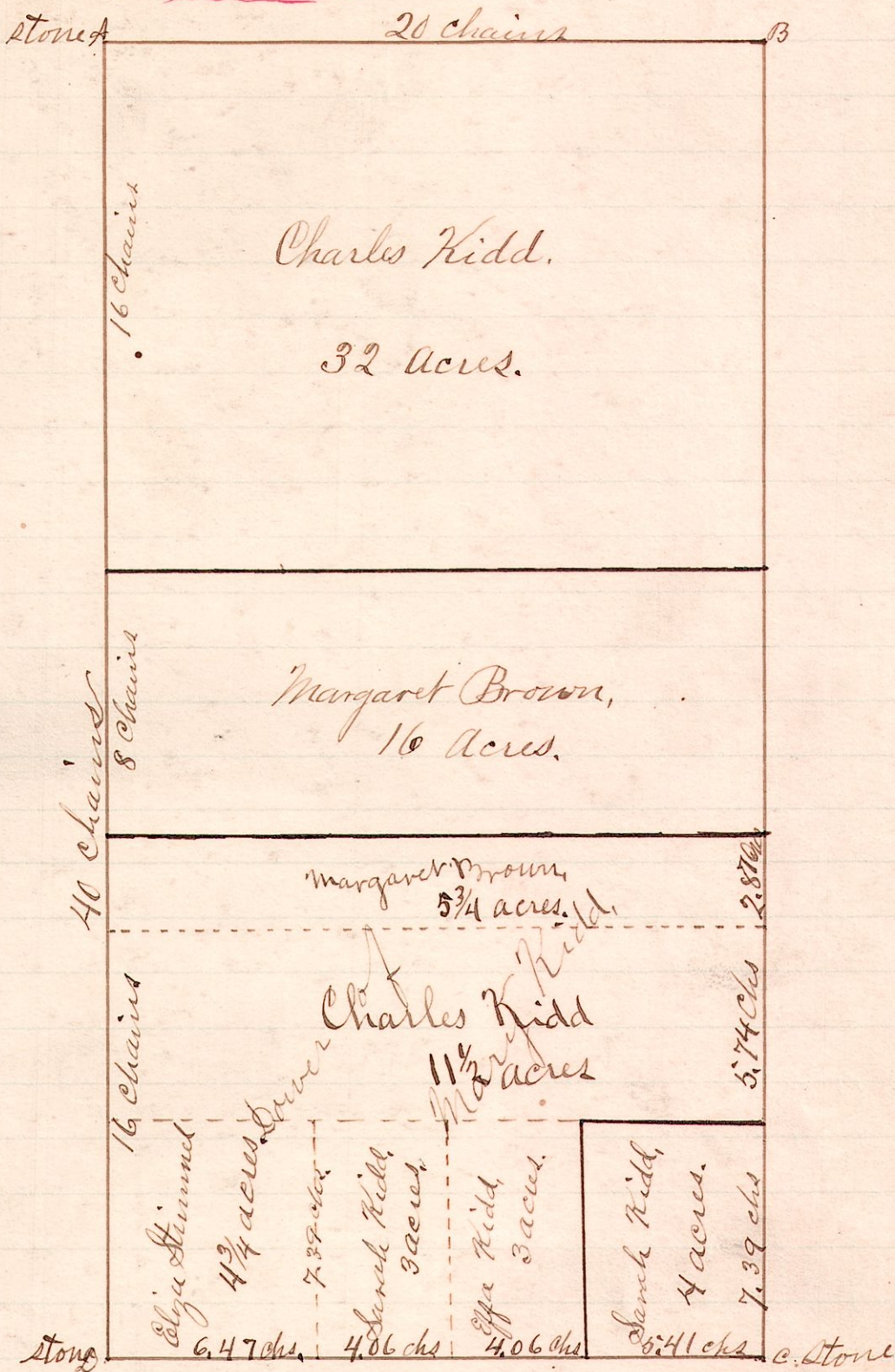

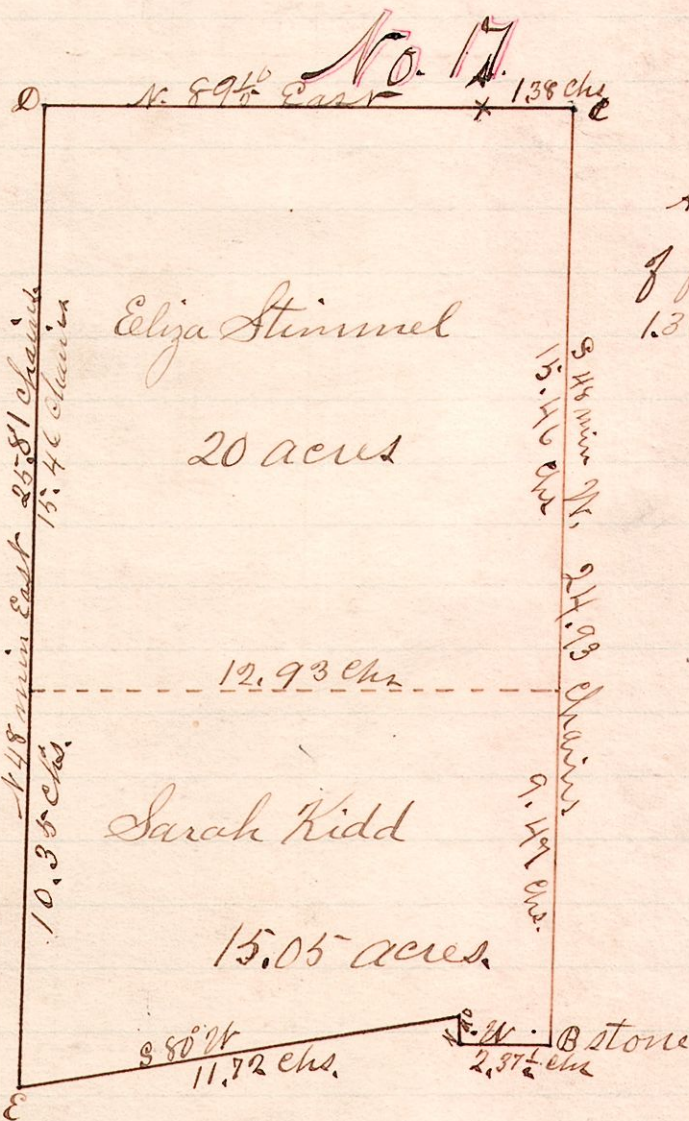


Notice in Partition.

 Beginning at a stake on the north line of said section 5 rods and 13 links east of the north quarter corner of said section; thence south 48 minutes west 99 rods and 18 links to a stake; thence west 9 1/2 rods; thence north 48 minutes east 3 rods and 15 links to a stake; thence south 80 degrees west 46 rods and 22 links to a stake; thence north 18 minutes east 103 rods and 6 links to the north-east corner of James Dehning's land on the north line of said section 22; thence north 89 degrees 12 minutes east along said line to the place of beginning, containing 35.05 acres.
