The "squares" are 33' and are divided into 4 lots
each $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet square.

The "Walks" are 4 and 6 feet wide as represented
on the Plat.

In case the Public Road, crossing the Addition,
should be vacated, the east half would make two half-squares
and the West half, a "walk" or "Drive" $12\frac{1}{2}$ feet wide with room
for a 4 foot "walk" between the half-squares and the squares
to the east of them.
