Interested parties are hereby notified to give said Surveyor the names of witnesses they wish subpoenaed and to be present at said survey.

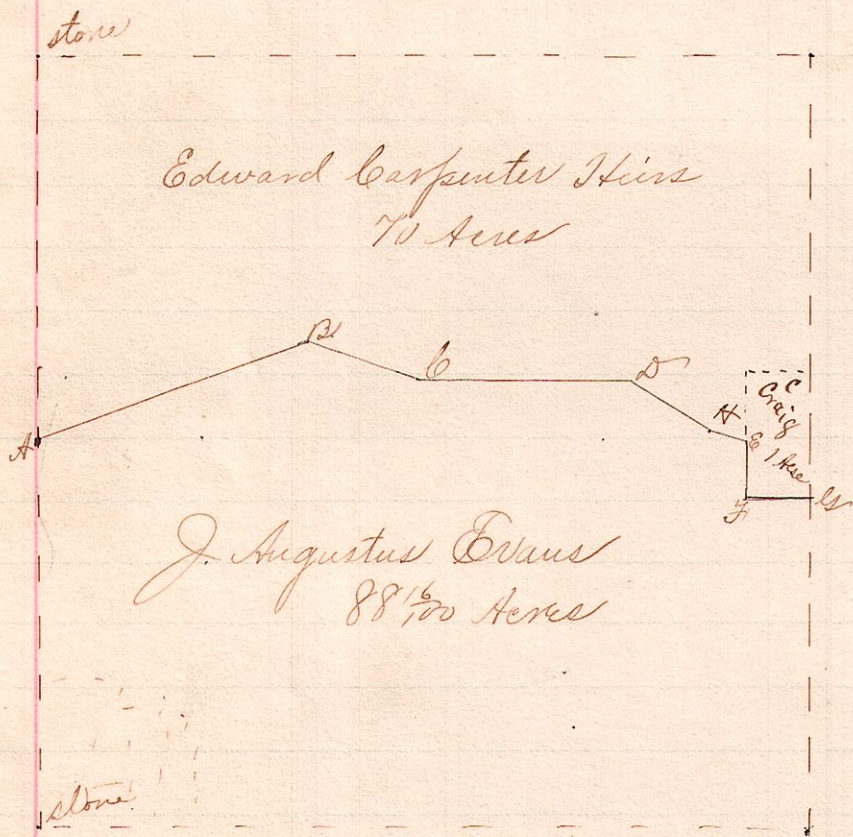
