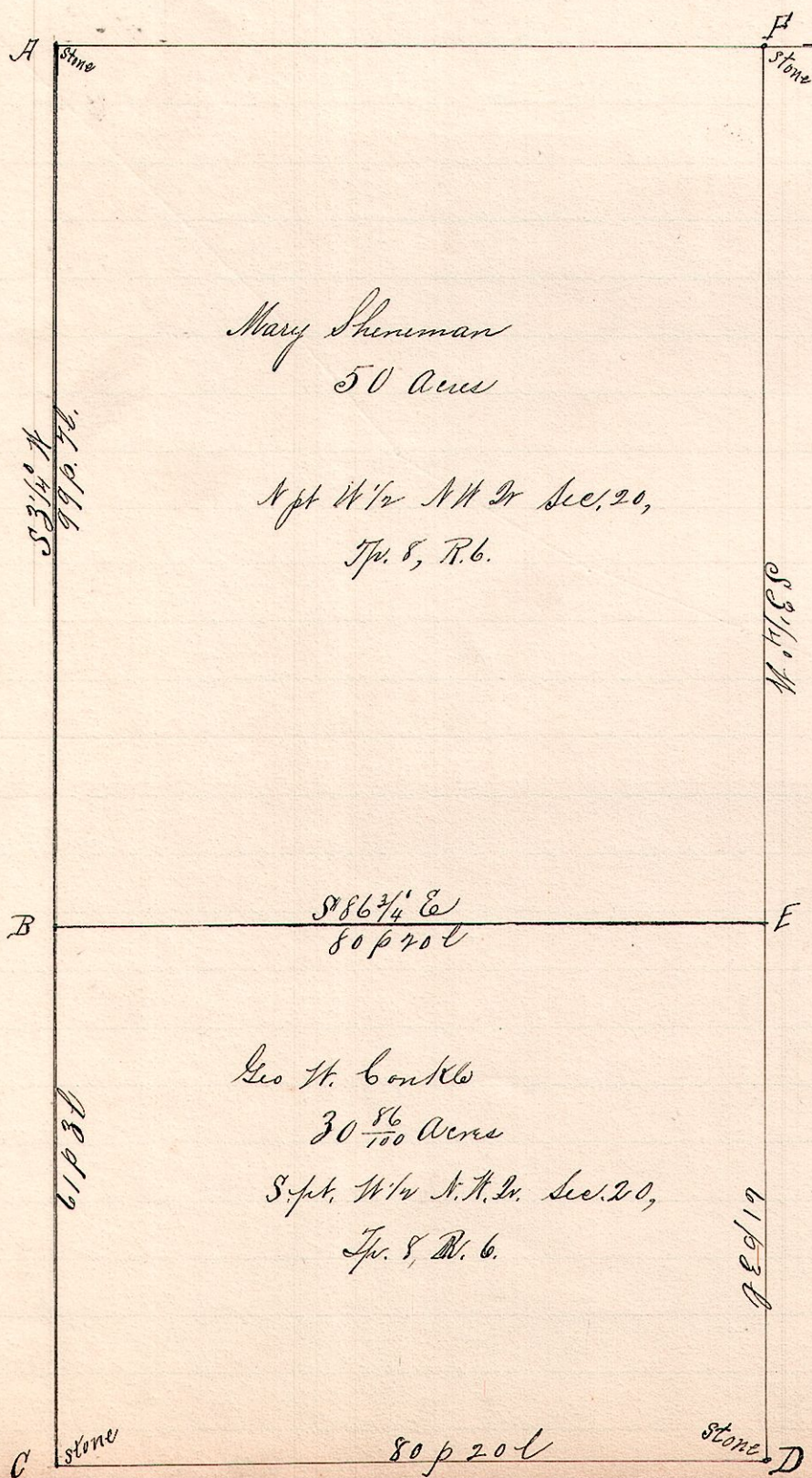

"B", the southwest corner of lands of Mary Sheneman's 50 acres, on west line said section S 3 1/4 W 99 p 7 l from "A". (Planted stone corner)

"C", a stone at the southwest corner of said northwest quarter is S 3 1/4 W 61 p 3 l south of "B".

"D", a stone at south half quarter post of said quarter is S 86 3/4 E 80 p 20 l from "C".

"E", is a stone at north half quarter post of said quarter

"F", a stone at the northeast corner said quarter section,
