 at said Survey.

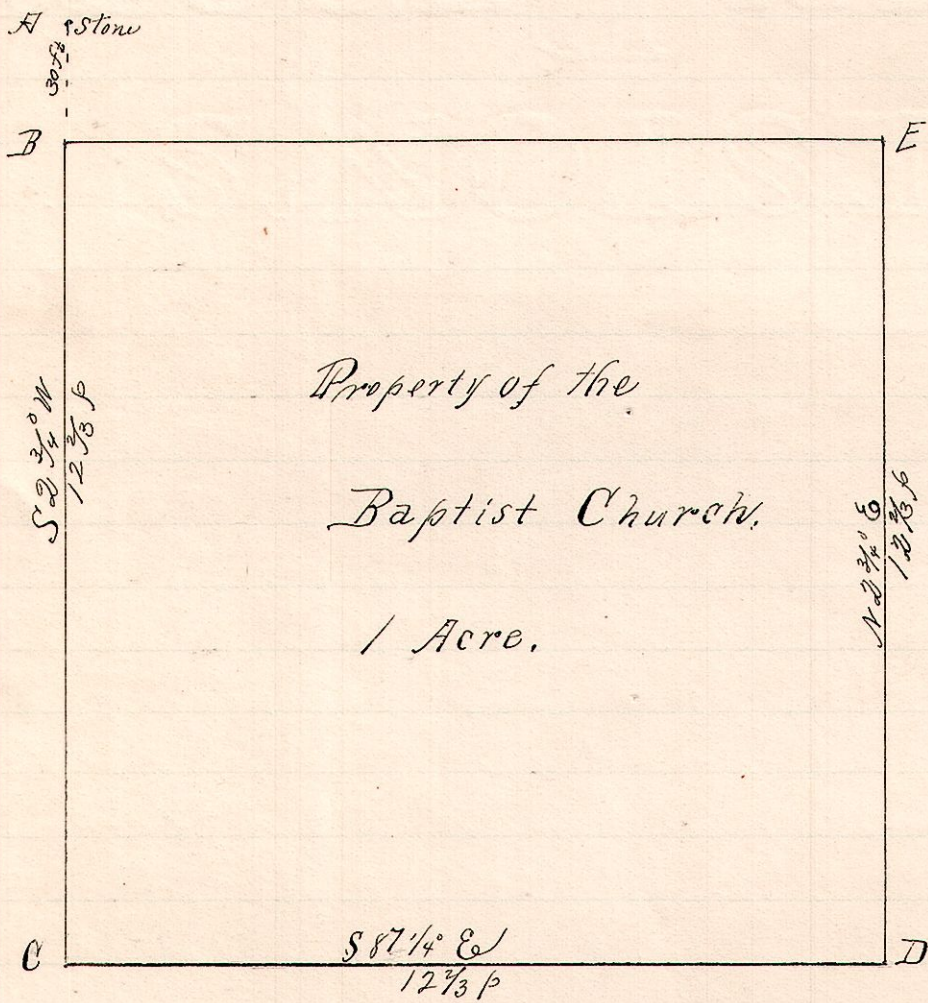
