Legal Survey Notice.

You are hereby notified that a survey will be made and testimony taken by the County Surveyor of Holmes County, Ohio, on the 25th day of Oct. 1897, between the hours of 10 A.M. and 4 P.M., and to continue from time to time at the request of said County Surveyor until the lines, boundaries and corners of the following described tract of land, now owned and held by James Carpenter & John H. Graham Hrs, et al, and situate in Kilbuck township, Holmes County, Ohio, can be established, being Sections 18th & 23rd of Tp. 8, R. 7.

Interested parties are hereby notified to give said Surveyor the names of witnesses they wish subpoenaed and to be present at said survey.

On the day therein named I proceeded to the premises to make said survey, selected the following persons, as chainmen, George Kerr & Y. E. Carpenter. Markers, P. M. Graham, Robt. Dugan, Stewart Carpenter (all sworn) others present, Charles Casey, James Carpenter, A. Graham, Matthew McChuggage, Isaac Swengood, John Casey.

We began at the south quarter post of Section 18, where we could find none of the original witnesses; a stake marked the corner, by common consent of the parties interested we established a stone corner where the post stood. We ran random line between sections 18th & 23rd, T. 8, R. 7. Also a line from said south quarter post N 3 1/4° E to N 1/4 post thence south from said south quarter post to the center of section 23, to a stone corner in the public road.

Also the east line of the northeast quarter of said section 23, all of which is represented by the plat on next page.

Took new witness to corner at center of section 18, marked "K" as follows

N. oak 10 N 79° 25' E 1 1/2 to N oak 6 S 67 1/2° W 12 1/2 L.
