## Legal Survey, notice.

To Geo. H. Slutz, admr. estate of Josiah Slutz heirs, William M<sup>c</sup>Clure  
John Frye, N. Ross, Levi Mast, W. H. Coley, John Fry, agt. W. H. Coley.

You are hereby notified that a survey will be made and testimony taken by the County Surveyor of Holmes County, Ohio, on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of Dec. 1892, between the hours of 10 A. M. and 4 P. M. and to continue from time to time, at the request of said County Surveyor until the lines, boundaries and corners of the following described tract of land, now owned and held by Henry S. Hochstetter, et al, and situate in Salterick township, Holmes County Ohio, can be established:

Being the west part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 2, Tp. 14, R. 12. Interested parties, are hereby notified to give said Surveyor the names of witnesses they wish subpoenaed and to be present at said survey.

On the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1892, I proceeded to the premises, began the survey, by selecting Henry Parker, Jr., and G. W. Godes, Chaimmen, and C. E. Howenstein, markers; all were duly sworn.

The south quarter corner of said Section 2, being lost, established the same by running a line S 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E, 332 perches, from a stone at the southwest corner of said section to the center of the square at Mt Hope, the southeast corner of said section, then dividing the distance placed a long boulder at road side for said south quarter. The corner at the center of the section being lost, it was established by running from the new south quarter corner to a stone at north quarter corner, bisecting this line, by a line running from a stone at West quarter corner to the stone at the east quarter corner in the public road; at the intersection of these lines, placed a new corner near a small box culvert in the public road. The east line of the west part of said southeast quarter being well defined, and a stone corner at each end 60 ft 10 links east of the new corners of said quarter, we again measured William M<sup>c</sup>Clure's 15 acres as described in the exception in the deed given to said Henry S. Hochstetter, as 80 p north and south by 30 p east & west, in the southwest corner of said tract, and established the corners of said tract, all of which proceedings is represented by the plat on the next page (377) of this Volume.
