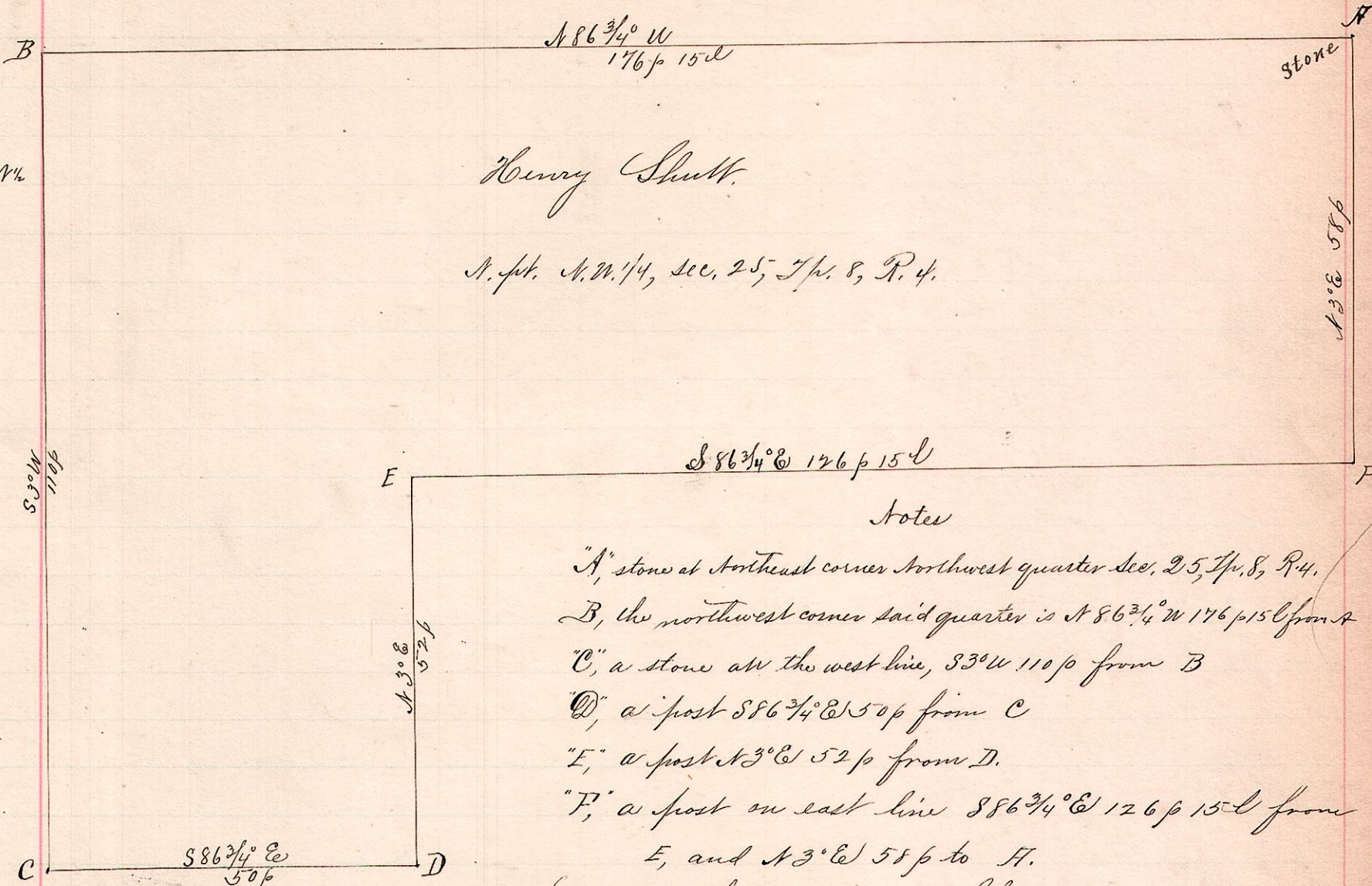

- "F", a post on east line $S 86\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} E 126 p 15 l$ from E, and $N 3^{\circ} E 58 p$ to H.

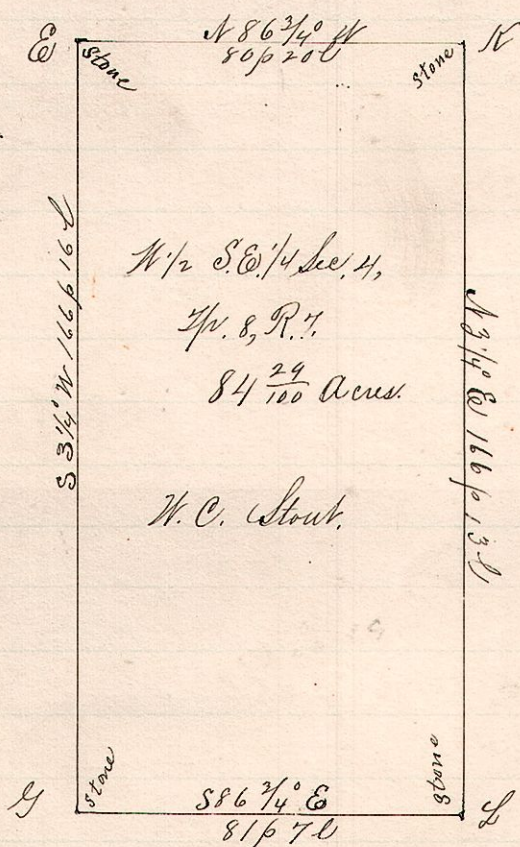
