

"A," a post in the public road leading from Millbank to Welcome in the S.W. 1/4 Sec. 6 Th 8 R⁷. $N 75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ 35 links from a Sycamore 30 inches.

"B," a post on the line between the Northwest Quarter and Southwest quarter said section 6 $N 21^{\circ} E$ 4 p 20 l from A.

"C," a post in said N.W. 1/4 Sec. 6, $N 21^{\circ} E$ 4 p 16 l from B.

"D," " " " " $N 41^{\circ} E$ 41 p 6 l " C.

"E," " " " " $N 60^{\circ} E$ 36 p 5 l " D.

"F," " on west line N.E. 1/4 Sec. 6, $N 56^{\circ} E$ 89 p 10 l " E.

"G," " in said N.E. 1/4 Sec. 6, $N 66^{\circ} E$ 21 p 4 l " F.

"H," " " " " $N 74^{\circ} E$ 34 p 10 l " G.

"I," " " " " $N 77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ 23 p " H.

"J," " " " " $N 87^{\circ} E$ 26 p 1 p " I.

"M," " " " " $N 85\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ 55 p 20 l " L.

"N," a post on line between N.E. 1/4 Sec. 6, and the N.W. 1/4 Sec. 7, $S 67\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ 23 p from M.

"O," a post in said N.W. 1/4 Sec. 7, $S 67\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ 13 p from N.

"P," the center of the stone culvert in the old Millisburg and Stewart State Road, the terminus of proposed route, $S 51^{\circ} E$ 2 p 4 l from O, and $S 30\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ 13 links from the NE corner of the stone abutment of said bridge.

The above road established 40 feet wide.
