

Notes.


"A" is a stone at the northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Sec 10, Tp 8, R 8.  
"B" a post on the east line of said quarter, at the northeast corner of the graveyard, S 31/2° W 6.60 chains from A.  
"C" the northwest corner of said graveyard is S 77 1/4° W 1.04 ch. from B.  
"D" the southwest corner of said graveyard, is S 31/2° W 2.41 ch. from C.  
"E" a post N 77° E 9 links from D.  
"F" a post S 31/2° W 1.9 chains from E.  
"G" a post on the east line of said quarter N 77° E 13 links from F.  
"H" a post on said east line, also on north line of the C.A. & C. Railway S 31/2° W 10 chains from G.  
"I" a post on north line of said Railroad N 87° 20' 6.28 ch. from H.  
"K" a post on the north line of said quarter N 31/2° East 37.25 chains from I, also S 86 1/2° E 6.25 ch to A.

"A" is a post at the southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Sec 10, Tp 8, R 8.

"B" a post on south line, N 86 1/2° W 11 1/2 p from A.  
"C" a post on the south line of the C.A. & C. Rail Road N 3 1/2° E 6 p 7 l from B.  
"D" a post on the east line of said quarter and on south line of said Rail road 382° E 11 p 15 l from C, also S 3 1/2° E 5 1/2 p. to A.
