You are hereby notified that a survey will be made ^{as} of testimony taken by the County Surveyor of Holmes County, Ohio, on the 19th day of March 1895, between the hours of 9 A.M. ^{and} 5 P.M., and to continue from time to time at the request of said County Surveyor until the lines, boundaries ^{and} corners of the following described tract of land, now owned ^{and} held by E. T. Johnson ^{and} Richard Miller ^{as} situate in Prairie Township, Holmes County, Ohio, can be established:

Being the Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Twp. 13, R. 13.

Interested parties are hereby notified to give said Surveyor the names of witnesses they wish subpoenaed and to be present at said survey.



On the 19th day of March, 1895, I proceeded to the premises, and commenced the survey by selecting Aaron McCulloch ^{and} John Smail as chainmen; Victor Glent ^{and} Arthur Crawford as markers, all were sworn. Began at the NW NW 1/4 Sec. 4 Twp. 13, R. 13; the following notes explain:

Notes.

A, the northwest corner of Sec. 4, Twp. 13, R. 13 was found and a large miggerhead stone placed where we found the old broken stone corner; took the following new witness: W oak 20 N 49° W 49 links and a maple 5 south 7° E 49 1/2 links

C, a stone at the southwest corner said Quarter South 1° 39' W 160 p 20 links from A; the original Hickory standing. Established B, the west half quarter post for said quarter half way between A and C on a large Boulder and took the following as new witness to B,

W oak 30 N 35 1/2° W 28 links

Jack Oak 20 N 92° E 36 links.

I hereby certify the above to be correct plat ^{and} notes of a survey of the west line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Twp. 13, R. 13, made to determine said west line ^{and} the half quarter on the same for E. T. Johnson ^{and} Richard Miller ^{and} others, March 19, 1895.
