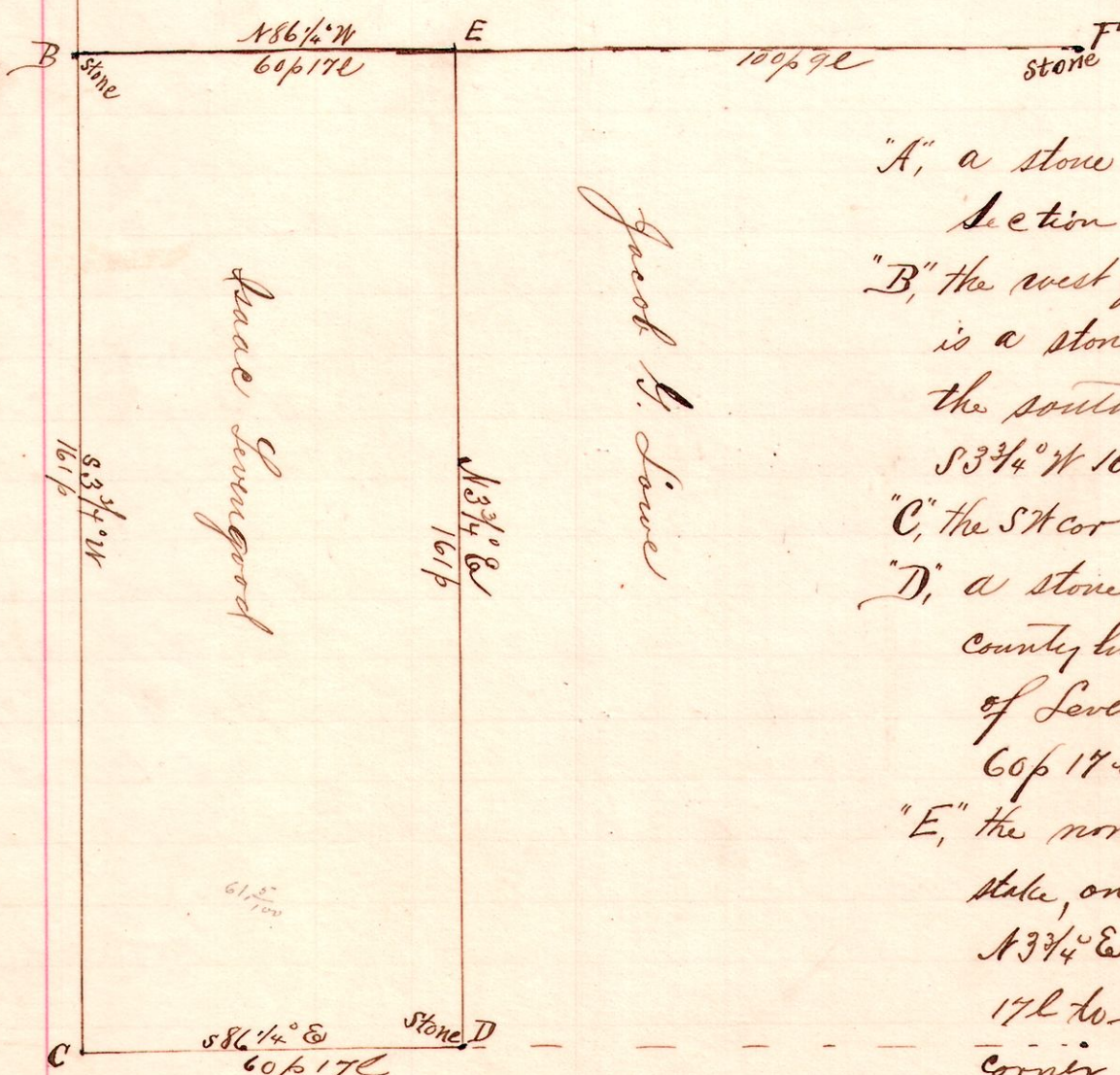

- "A," a stone at the Northwest corner of Section 23 T. 8, R. 7.
- "B," the west quarter corner of said sec. is a stone at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of said Sec. 23 S 3 3/4° W 161 p from A.
- "C," the SW cor on Co line S 3 3/4° W 161 p from B.
- "D," a stone in the graveyard, on the county line, at the Southeast corner of Lvingoods land S 86 1/4° E 60 p 17 l from C.
- "E," the northeast corner, we found a stake, on the north line of said quarter, N 3 3/4° E 161 p from D, and N 86 1/4° W 60 p 17 l to B; we placed a new stone corner with glass and pottery under it. Stone 3 feet 4 inches long.
