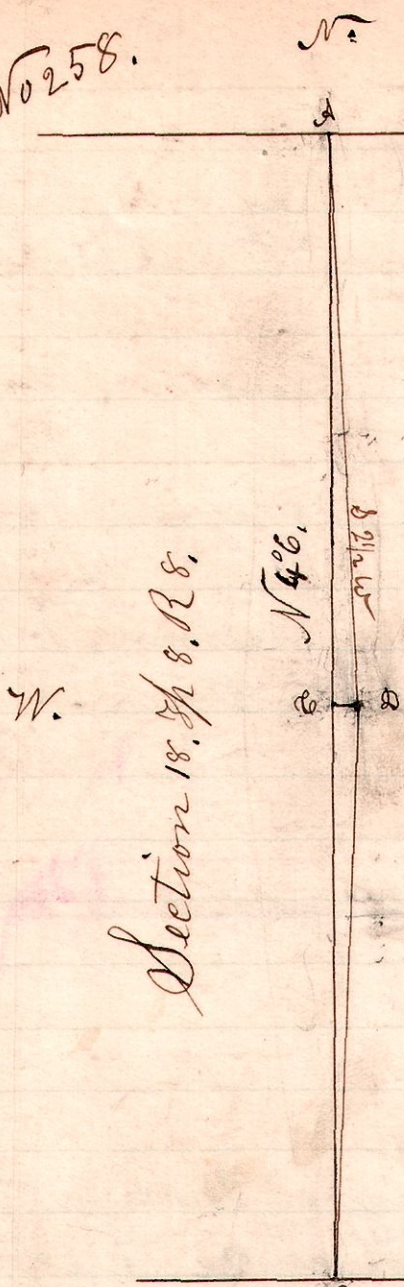

A Survey made for Sherman Ross and others to show a straight line north and south between sections 18 and 19, in Township 8. of Range 8, and to investigate the difference between a straight line, and the line as fenced at the present time. I took to my assistance Luther Purdy and Wm Meiddaugh, who were sworn by me.

A. C. B. Represent a straight line between the two sections north and south.

A. D. B. Represent the line as now fenced.

C. D. are 3 perches and 22 links apart

A. C. D. contains 1<sup>94</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Acres.

As to the point D being an original corner, Luther Purdy after being duly sworn, says. He is 57 years old, and has been a resident of this neighborhood all his life, except 18 months.

Question; How long have you known the quarter corner between sections 18 and 19. T. 8. R. 8.

Q. Ans. Have known it for 50 years or over. Within one foot of where that post stands (pointing to the point D) Did you ever see a stone there that was taken as a corner. Ans. Yes sir, many a time. Q. How long has there been a fence, as now located. About 50 years. Within a few feet.

Aaron Turner being duly sworn says; He is a resident of sec 18. T. 8. R. 8. Age 57. Lived here since 1868. Q. Did you ever see a stone here that was considered a corner stone. Yes. Q. Where. About here (pointing to a place just north of post at D) Q. Were the fences running north and south where they now are. Ans. Yes.

Henry Meiddaugh being first duly sworn, says; He is a resident of Section 19. in T. 8. R. 8, am 77 years old, have lived here 32 years. Q. Did you ever see a corner stone between sections 18 and 19, half way. Yes sir, many a time, first about 52 years ago. Has the fence always been where it now is. Ans. yes.
