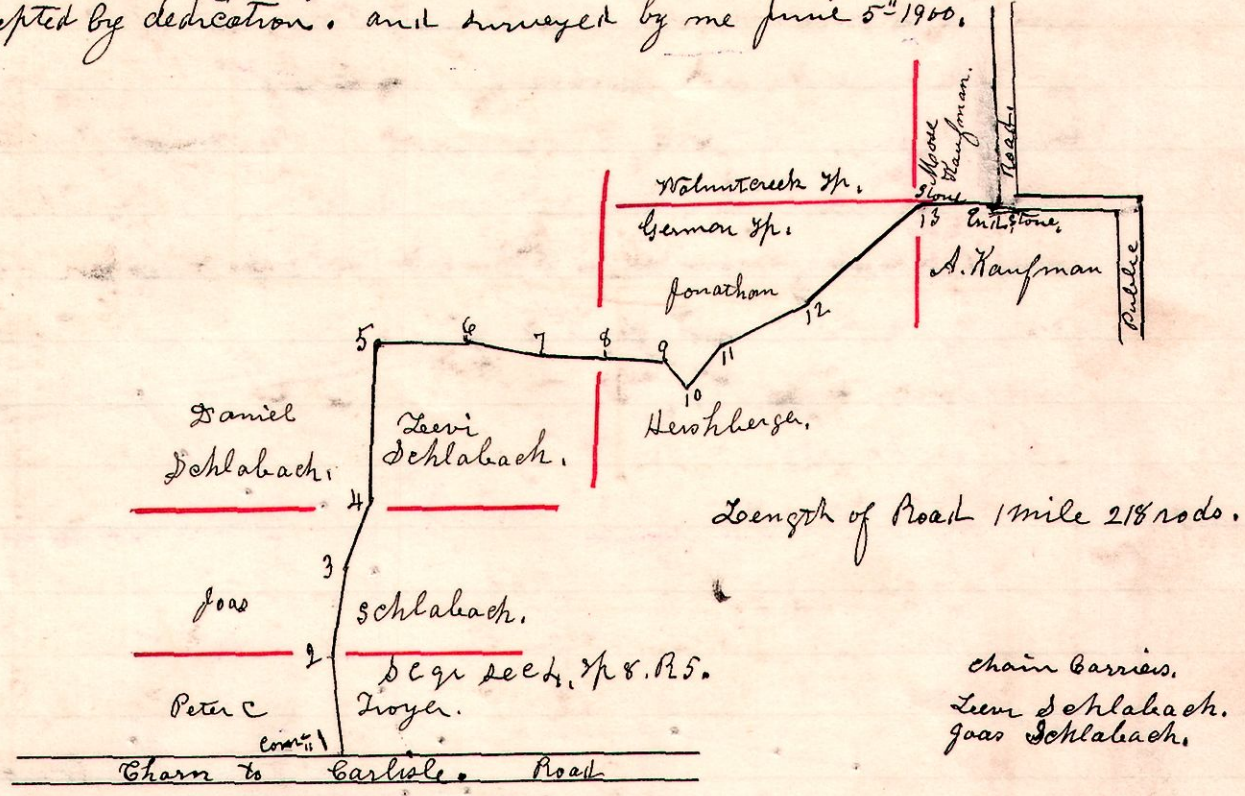

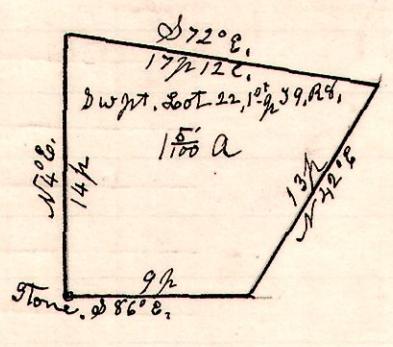
A county road petitioned for by Levi Schlabaek and others of German Sp., asking that the same be accepted by dedication. and surveyed by me June 5th 1900.

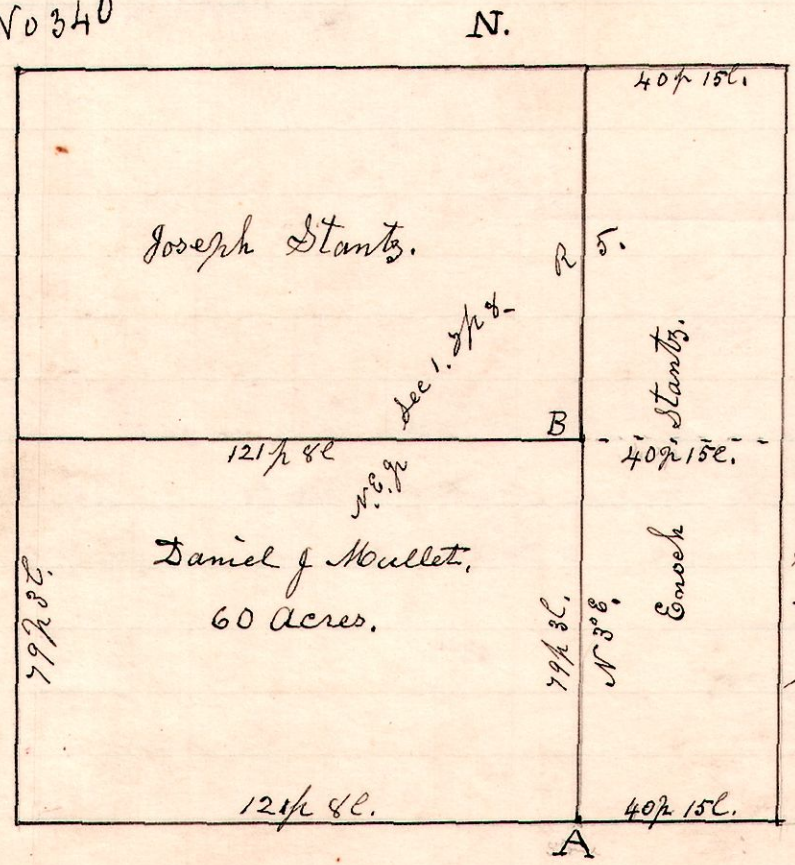

A survey made for D. J. Mullett to locate the line A. B. between lands of D. J. Mullett and Enoch Stantz, the same being in dispute. The deed of both parties, corners their land at a stone corner established E) Nov 14th 1860 by Joseph Edgar, Co Surveyor. On investigation & measurements I found said stone to be correct. I then went to B, and established that corner by measurements, and the stump of a witness taken, and recorded by Edgar in Vol 202 of Surveys. I then established the line between A & B.

The balance of this plat is copied from Edgar survey so far as the 60 acres is concerned. Daniel J. Mullett and Enoch Stantz both agree in presence of witnesses to accept and abide by my survey.
