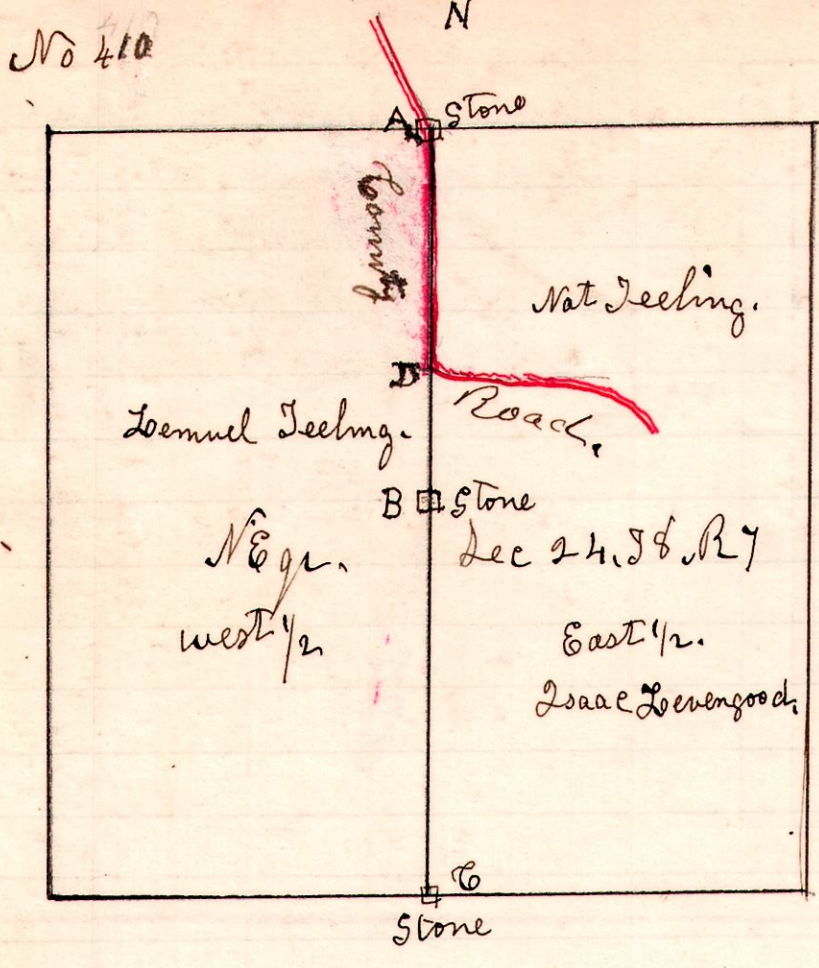

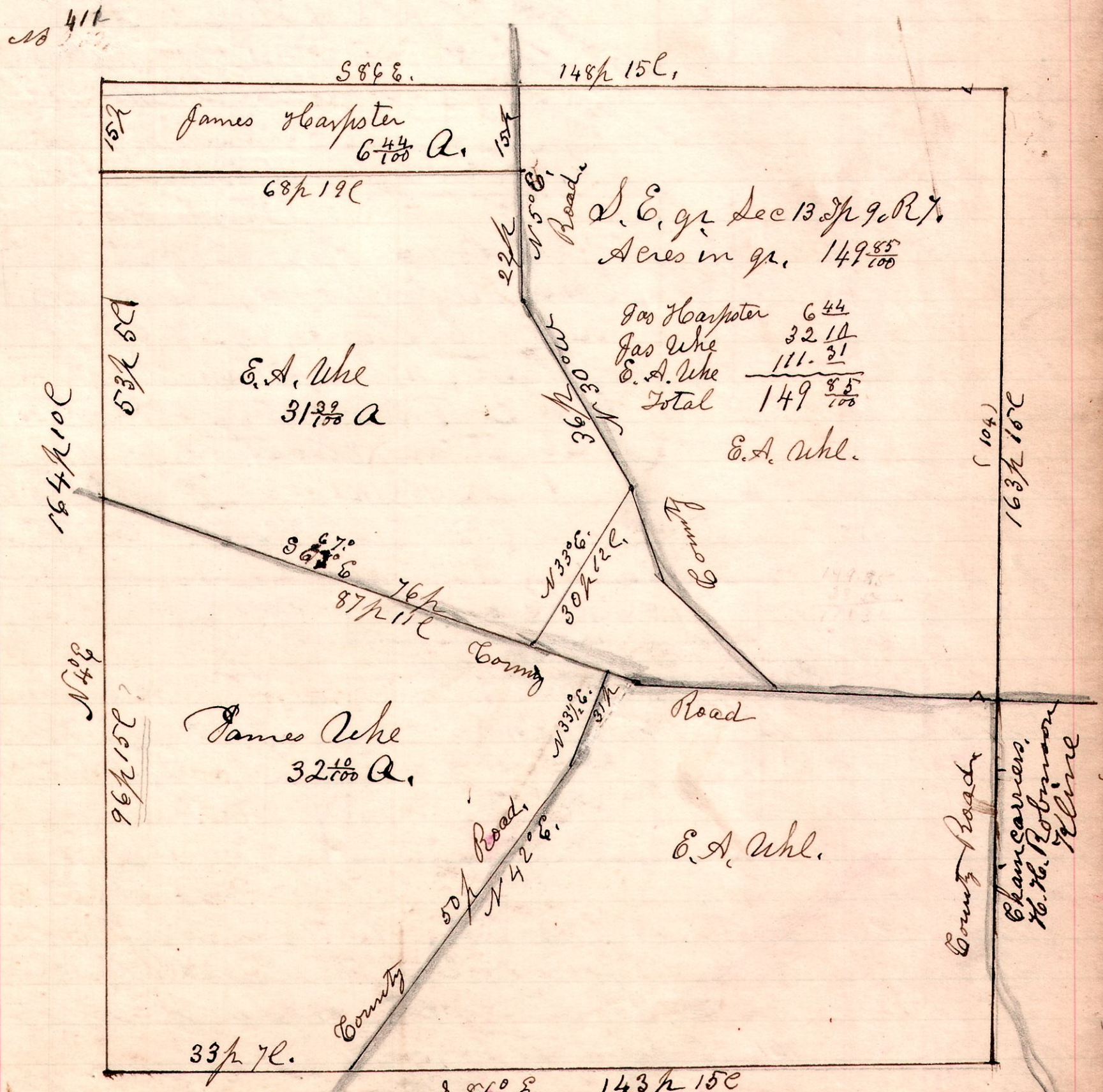

The road is by law 60 feet in width, but 30 feet is all sufficient for a road at that point, So I located the center of the road, and staked off 15 feet at each side of the center line, the parties agreeing to set out fences, and give that width. June 12<sup>th</sup> 1902.
