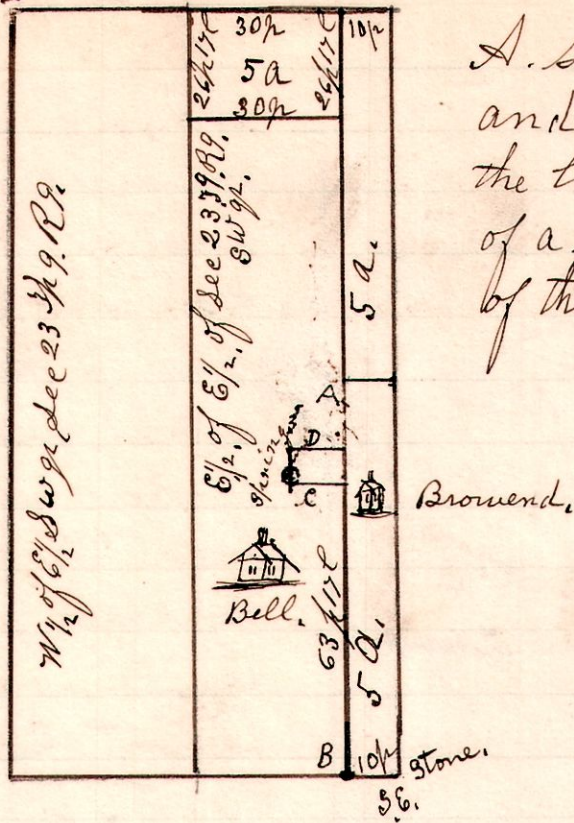

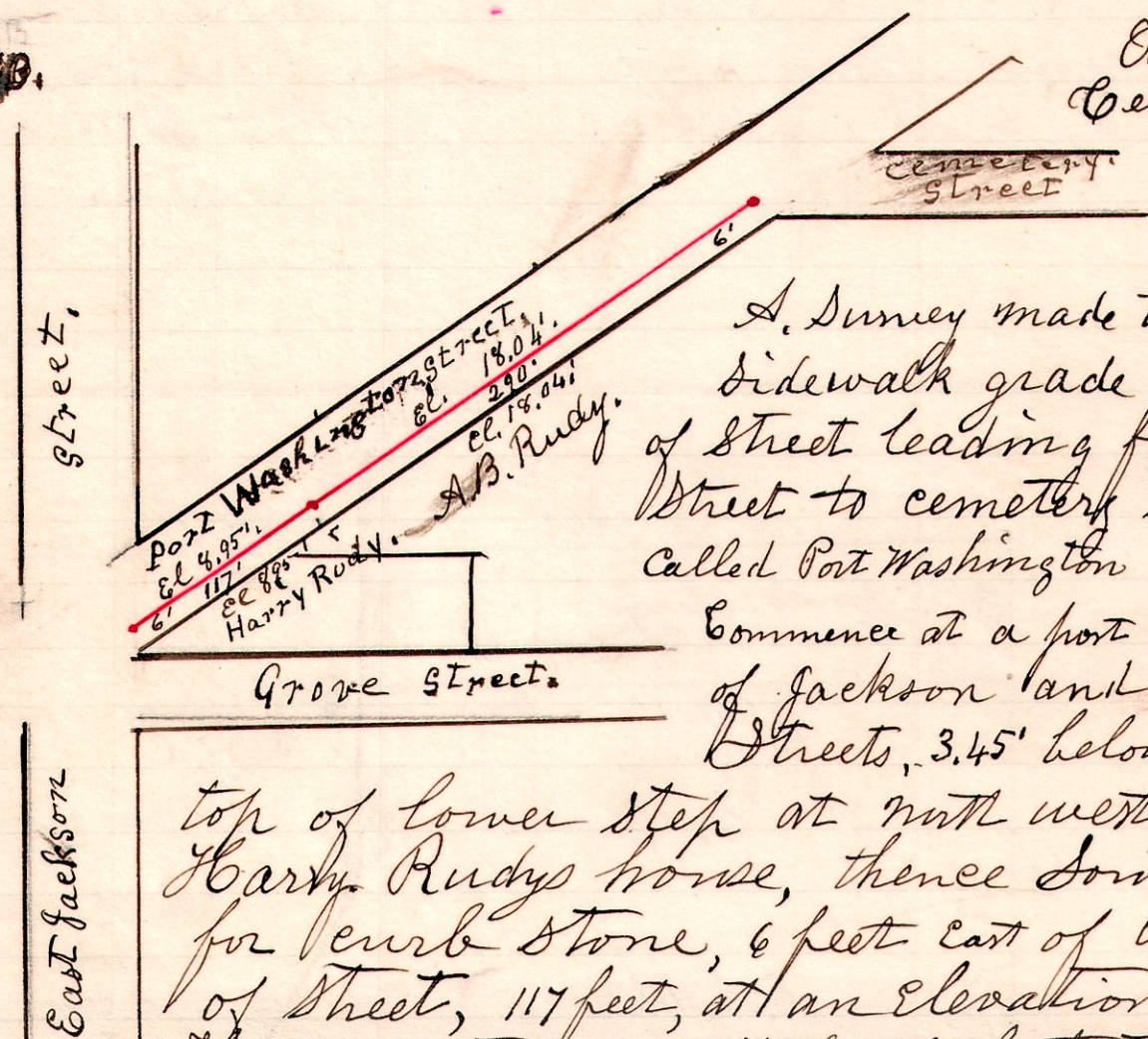

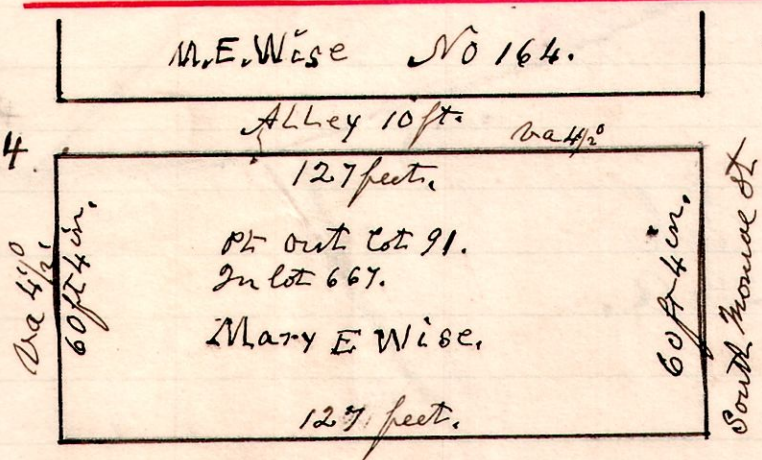
A. Survey made to establish sidewalk grade on west side of street leading from Jackson Street to cemetery street. Called Port Washington St. Commence at a point at intersection of Jackson and Port Washington Streets, 3.45' below level with top of lower step at north west corner of Harry Rudys house, thence South Easterly, for curb stone, 6 feet east of west line of street, 117 feet, at an elevation of 8.95'. Thence continue easterly 290 feet to Cemetery Street at an elevation of 18.04 feet.
