



Survey of route for alteration of public road leading from Holmesville to Millerling, at what is known as deep cut South of Holmesville, The purpose of the alteration is to do away with the present grade crossing over the C. A. & C. Rail way, and to substitute an overhead crossing over said Rail way.

The ground for the new road was dedicated by D. H. Croes, and being in Section 10, in T. 13, of Range 13, Commencing where

the present public road turns east from near D. H. Croes barn, and west of the present grade crossing. Commencing at a Locust tree on the South side of the present road; Thence South 32° East 714 feet to a Post on the west side of the C. A. & C. right of way, and being 40 feet in width.
