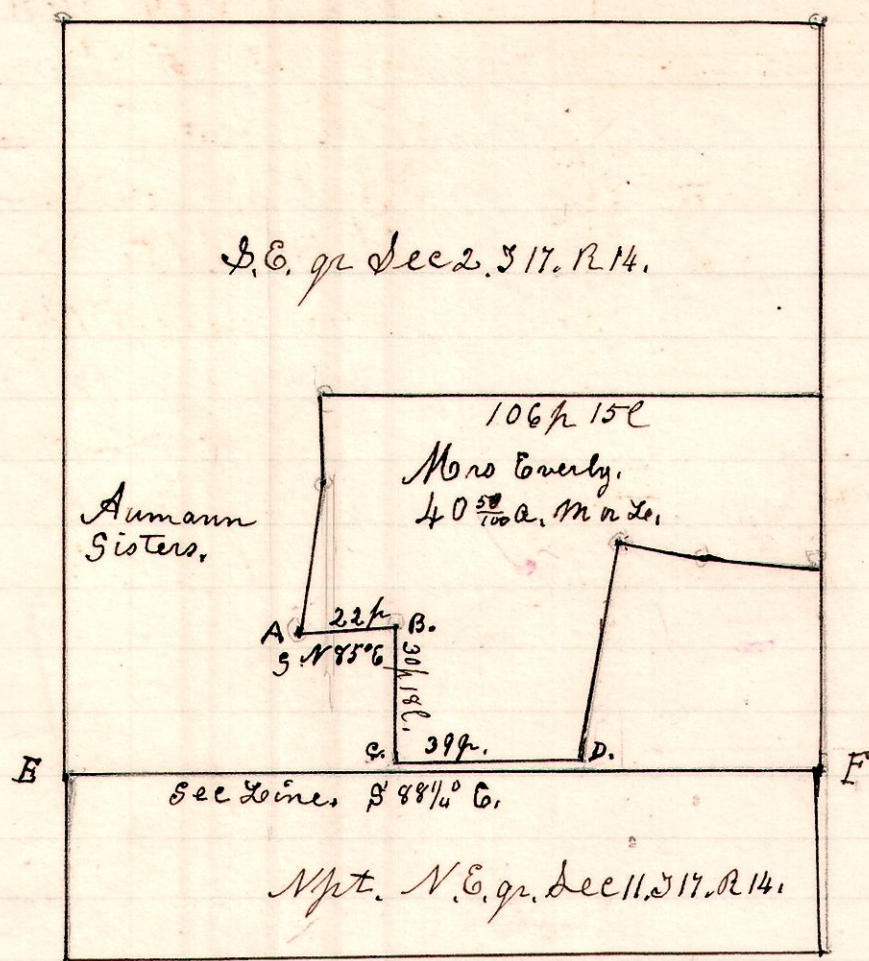

A legal Survey made January 3rd 1906. To locate the line **B.C.**, as described in deeds for the $40\frac{5}{100}$ acre tract of land. Commenced at the corner **A.**, which is described as in the center of the public road leading from Leondomville to Bolivar. From that point I located the corner **B.**, then measured the line **B.C.**, being 30 furlongs and 18 links, which fell short 8 feet of reaching a post on the South line of said South East quarter of Section 2, T. 17. R. 14. On April 1906. I carefully located the line **B.F.**, being the line between the South East quarter of Section No 2, and the North East corner of Section 11, T. 17. R. 14.
