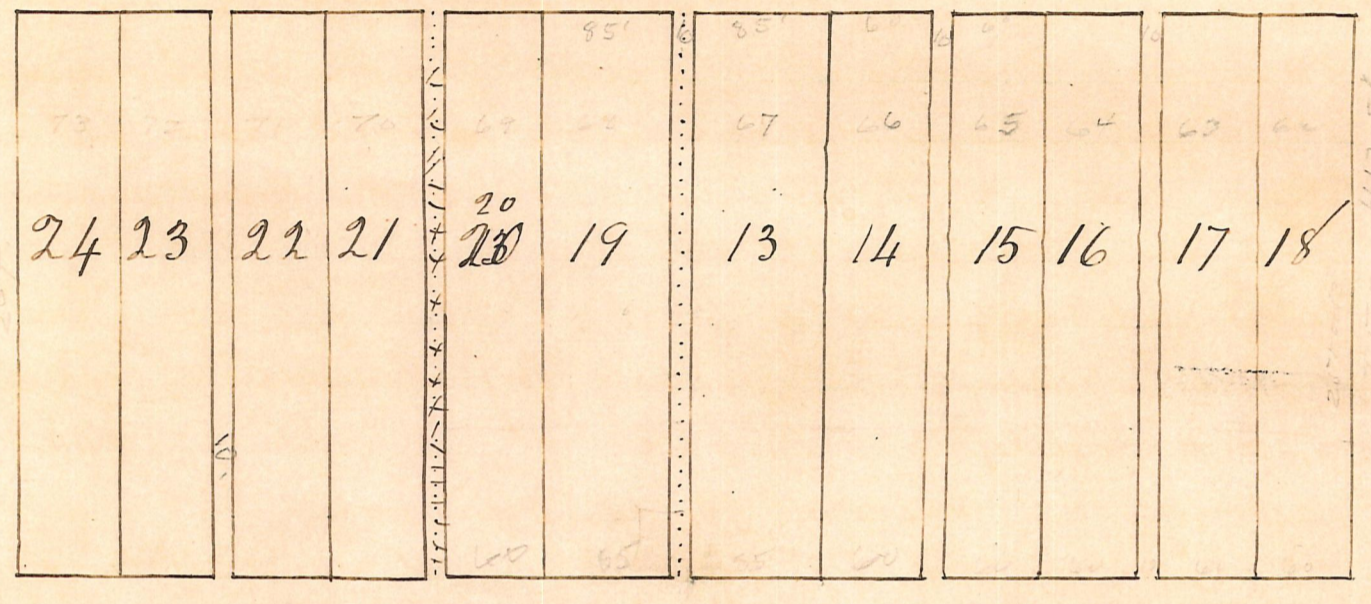


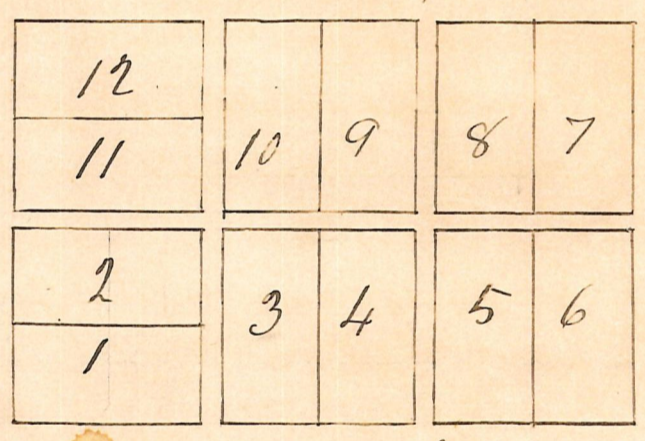
Deed 10-

Napoleon
Town plat
2nd Addition

Napoleon Sept 23^d 1843 Surveyed the
2nd addition to the town of Napoleon in Richland
Township Holmes county Ohio, for Parmenas Barnes
and Ephraim Darby, commencing at the standard
corner of the original Town plat and running N. 0° 50' East. 60 feet across
Main Street which is the North Street of the original town plat, and laid
off 24 lots of which the following is a correct plat, on a scale of 60 feet to 1/2 an
inch, and bearing N 50' E. & S 89° 10' E. Length of lots 120 feet except the 12 lots
on the North, which are the same width of the others and 25 perches long, with the
exception of 13 and 19 which are 85 feet wide. The Alleys are 10 feet wide,

Main Street 60 ft wide

N.B. that lots No 1 and 2
are divided North and South.
