

Smith Street

Runs South 89° 30' W from Market Street to the west line of the before described addition is sixty six feet wide and is between lots No 53 & 59 on Market - and lots 58 & 64 at the west end. Benton Street Runs S 89° 30' W from the Station grounds to the South west Corner of the before described addition is sixteen and one half feet wide - the south line of this street is the south line of this addition.

Woods Street

Runs S 1° 08' E from Jackson Street to Jefferson Street is thirty three feet wide and in (Streets and Alleys Continued) Connection with Woods Street in the Town of Holmesville is sixty six feet wide.

Market Street Runs N 8° 19' E from Benton Street to the North west Corner of lot No 78 thence N 30° 50' E to Jackson Street and is one hundred feet wide the west line of this Street is continued straight from Benton to Jefferson Streets There is a space left for a passage from Market Street to the Station grounds of eight two and two tenths feet between lots No 80 & 90 and runs S 59° 10' E. there is also a space left for a passage from Market Street to the Station grounds of one hundred and eight and seven tenths feet between lots No 94 & 110. This space is situated so that the North west Corner of lot 94 is on a line with the south side of Main Street and the South East Corner of lot 110 is on a line with the north side of Main Street

Alleys

All Alleys running east & west on the north side of Jefferson Street run S 89° 30' W and are twelve feet wide - on the south side of Jefferson Street runs S 89° 30' W and are twelve feet wide. The Alley on the East side of lot No 107 runs N 1° 08' E and is twelve feet wide. Perkins Lots Numbered in blue, Smiths in red.

Stone corners from which future surveys are to be made and planted at the south west Corner of lot No 70. at the North East Corner of No 78. and the North west Corner of lot No 74. Courses Magnetic taken with an instrument having an East Variation of 1°
