Calhoun the County Surveyor on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 1878 between the hours of 7 a.m. & 7 p.m. and continue from day to day until finished with Lot 19 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Township 9 of Range 9 for the purpose of Establishing the lines and corners at the ends thereof between the heirs of Adam Smith and Mrs J. B. Breen Widow
