


## David J. Staubach, Land.

Two chains to the inch.



A Survey made for Noah J. Miller, on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1843 being in the North east corner of the west half of the south east quarter of section 7, Tp 8 & R 5, of Holmes County Ohio. Commencing at the N & corner of said west half, thence S  $\frac{1}{2}$  E 10 chains 814 links hence N 64° 30' W 7 chains 52 links, thence N 59° 27' W 3 chains 20 links, thence N 13° 27' W 14 chains 99 links thence N 32° W 3 chains 91 links, thence due East 13 chains 20 links to the placeal beginning containing 9 acres  $\frac{89}{100}$  of an acre more or less  
Stakes put in at the corners.
