

Auditors Journal entry in Matter pertaining to Incorporating Holmesville, Ohio

Auditor's office Holmes County,

Monday 1 P.M. Millersburg O. May-9-1892.

The Board met to hear and consider the petition and remonstrance The petitioners were represented by W. S. Hanna and the remonstrators by John S. Maxwell Esq. The Attorney for remonstrators made the following motion to dismiss the petition. In the matter of the petition of R. P. Loller and A. J. Boner et al for the Incorporation of Holmesville Holmes Co. O.

Now comes R. S. Flack and others remonstrators and moves your Hon Body to dismiss the petition for said Incorporation for the reason that less than thirty persons, voters within the territory and residents thereon included within said proposed Incorporation now remain on said petition asking for such Incorporation.

The above motion was overruled, there being 33 names attached to the petition all resident voters at the time the petition was presented, the Board of Commissioners holding that their jurisdiction attached when the petition was presented to them. The Board having found every thing correct as required in Section 1558. The case was then heard by Affidavits and parole testimony and argued by Counsel, After which the Board adjourned to Meet to Morrow morning at 9. a. m.

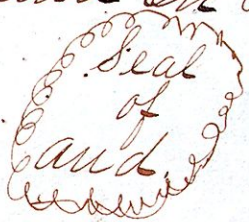
