

On the 14th day of March 1895, the same being not less than six weeks prior to the hearing; and that all necessary preliminary steps in this matter have been properly taken, and said board of commissioners viewing same to pass on the merits of this matter from the testimony, find that the Petitioner contains all the matters required by the statutes in such cases that the statement of the Petitioner are true that the tract of each of said tracts proposed to be annexed to said village are accurately described and are not in either tract unnecessarily large or small; that the map or plat accompanying said Petition and bounding the several tracts proposed to be annexed is accurate, that the Person whose name is subscribed to said Petition was duly authorized in the premises by said village; that notice has been given as required; that it is right and proper that the prayer of said Petition be granted; It is therefore on this 17th day of May 1895. ordered by the board that the territory described in said Petition be and the same is hereby annexed to said incorporated village of Killbuck and made part thereof as prayed for in the Petition; that the recorder enter all the proceedings and orders made by the board in this matter upon the journal and cause a transcript thereof together with the petition and plat to be forwarded to the Clerk of said incorporated village

D. and W. Duncanson fire fence; thence west on line of said fence to the East line of the Right of way of the Dresden branch Railway; thence in a northerly direction on said easterly line of Right of way to the Public Road fence; thence in North East direction along said fence to a stone; thence North to center of Killbuck creek;
