

ORDINANCE TO VACATE ALLEY

ORDINANCE NO. 198

TO VACATE THE TWELVE (12) FOOT ALLEY RUNNING EAST AND WEST BETWEEN LOTS 116 and 119 ON THE SOUTH AND LOTS 117 and 118 ON THE NORTH FROM GENERAL TAYLOR STREET TO VERMILLION STREET.

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of December, Nineteen Hundred and Sixty-Eight (1968), a petition by persons owning Lots in the immediate vicinity of the twelve (12) foot alley from General Taylor Street to Vermillion Street separating Lots 116 and 119 from Lots 117 and 118 was duly presented to Council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated, and together with said petition was filed the consent of the property owners abutting on General Taylor Street and notice of the pendency and filing of said petition has been given as requested by law by posting in five (5) public places in said Village for six (6) weeks as required by law, and,

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Holmesville, State of Ohio,

SECTION 1: That the twelve (12) foot alley running east and west from General Taylor Street to Vermillion Street separating Lots 116 and 119 from Lots 117 and 118 be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

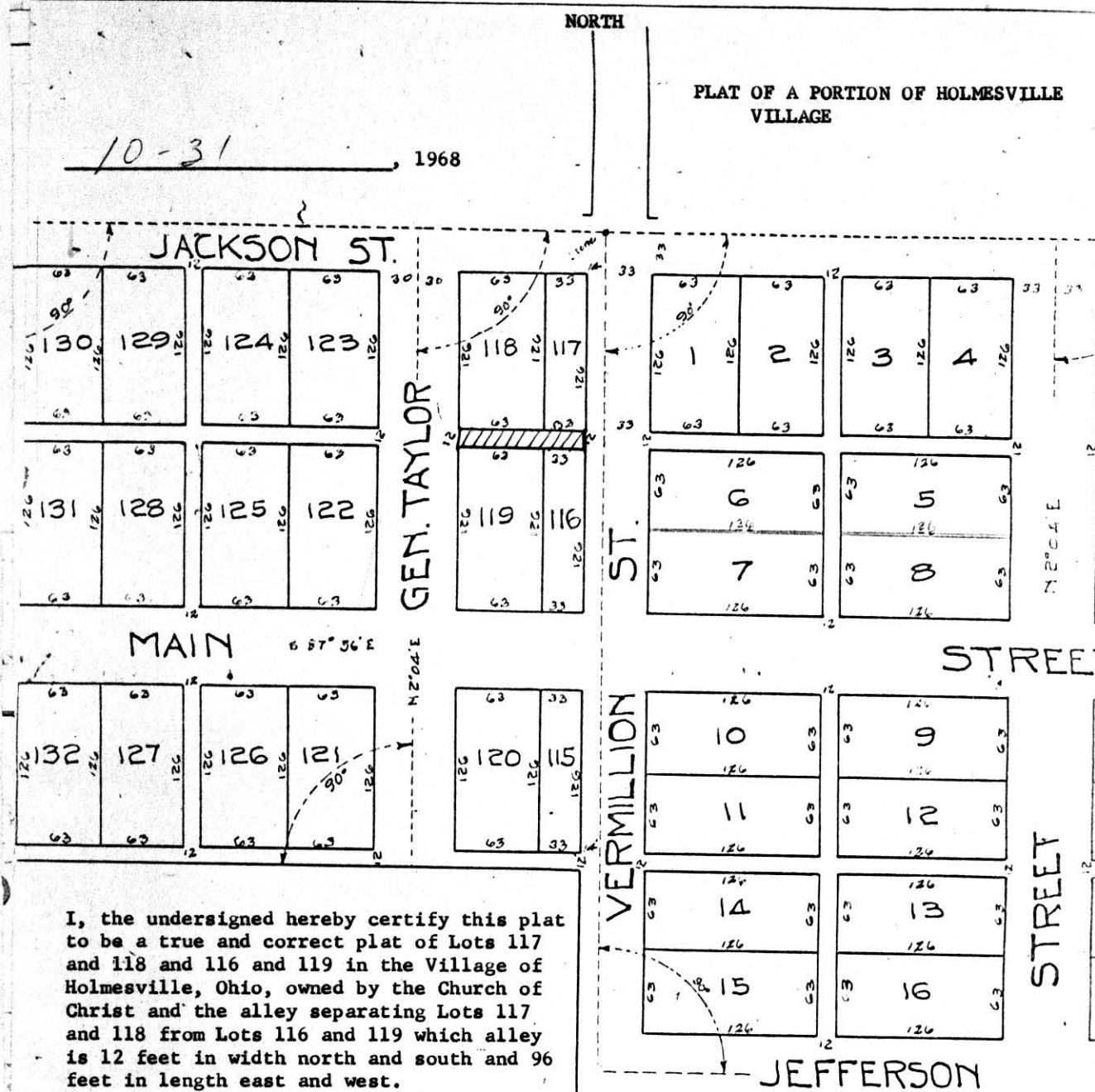

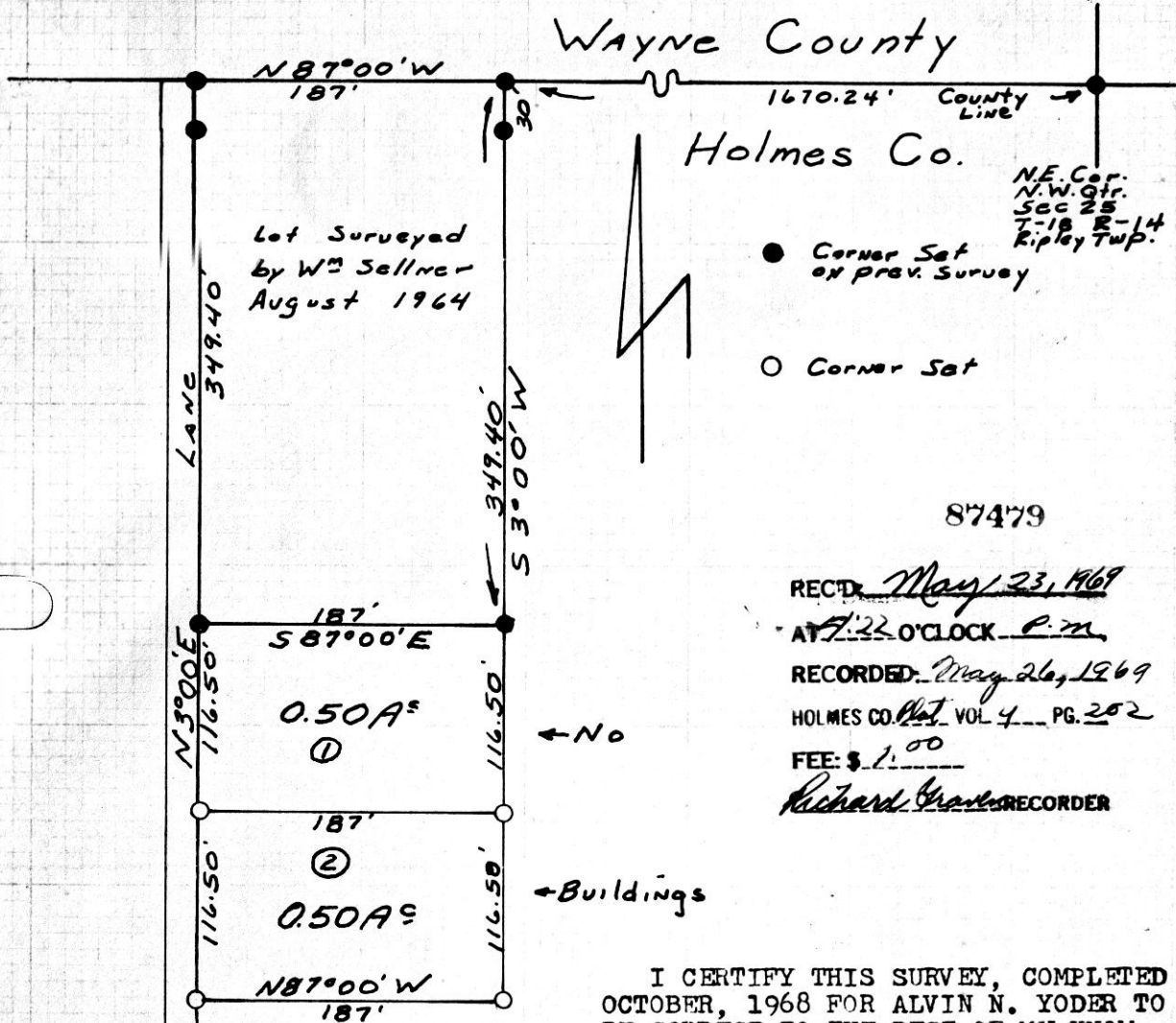
