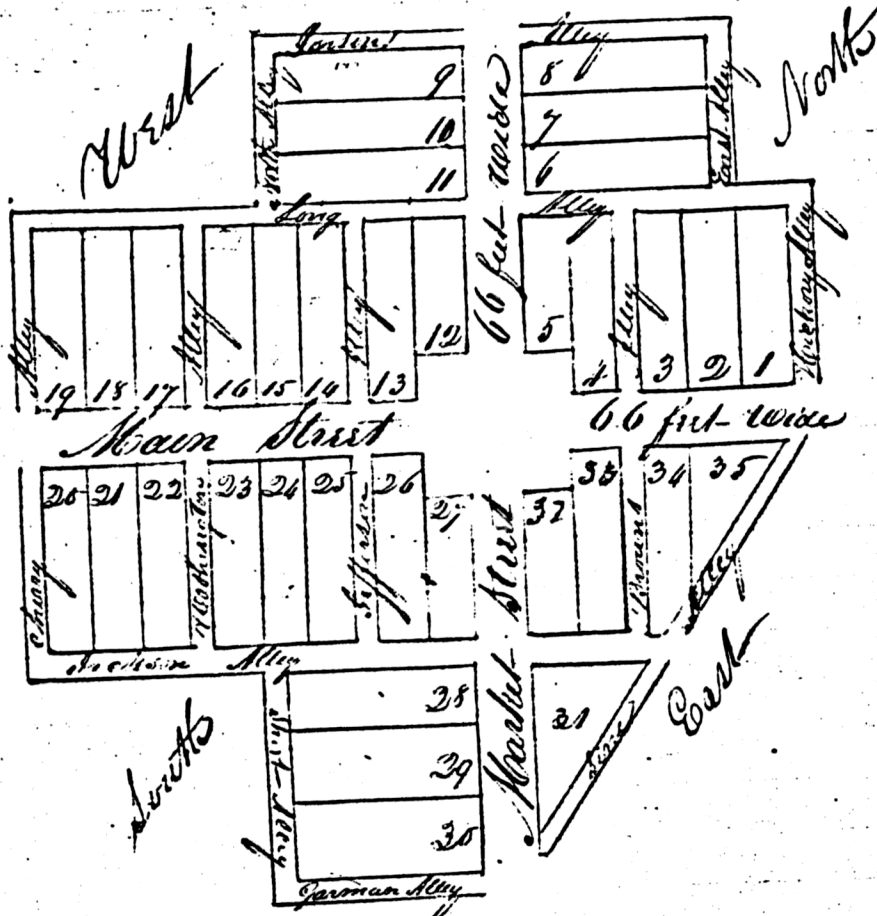


A Plat of Farmerstown laid off in German Township

It is hereby certified, that the above is a true Plat of the Town of Farmerstown
 Main Street runs direct South West, from N.E. and Market Street runs from
 N.W. direct S.E. Each street is 66 feet wide and the same cross each other,
 there is a center of two foot squares for the public and each Alley is 16 1/2 feet
 wide and each lot is fronting 49 1/2 feet & 198 in depth except Nos. 5, 12, 27, 32
 are only 148 1/2 feet deep & Nos. 34 & 35 are fractions No. 31 contains 31 1/2 Acres and
 No. 35 contains 27 Acres & each Street & Public square & Alley are five to ten feet
