Feet Wide Along The Line On The West Side Of 10/2 Acres For A

Wagon Road For The Use Of Samuel Gray." Samuel Gray Was

The Original Owner Of The 40.5 Acre Tract.


David Maxwell Owned The Entire West Part Of The Section

In 1866 (Vol. 30, Pg.81). It Was Maxwell Who Split Out The 10/2 Acres And The 40/2 Acres. There is No Deed Specifically Transferring The 12 Foot Strip To Apy Owner Of The 40/2 Acre

The Current Deed For The 40 % Acre Tract States "... The Use And Priviledge Of 12 Feet Along The West Side Of A 101/2 Acre Parcel " This Wording Has Been Repeated At Least Since 1912. See Vol. 79, Pg. 345.

In Summary, I Can Find No Evidence Giving Stephen T. & Karen A Smith Ownership Of The 12 Foot Strip, Only The Right To Use It For Access.
