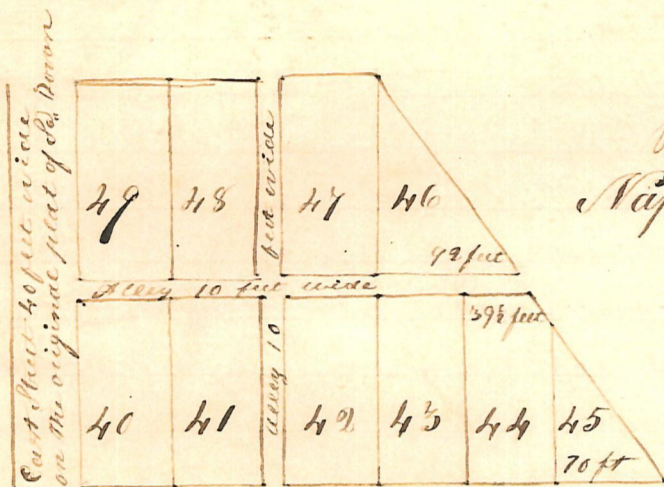


Asa Britchfield add.



Plat of an Addition of the town of Napoleon in Holmes County Ohio

The above plat is a plan of an addition to the town of Napoleon sets forth the air lots by numbers in said town including (No 39 which lies East of lots Nos 37 & 38 in the original town plat surveyed by James Robinson A.D 1831 their length and breadth with the width of the streets and alleys. Being a part of the North East 2d of the West half of the South West 2d of Section No 1 in T. 8. R. 9. Commencing at the corner of East Street and Lot No 47 - Lots Nos 40. 41. 42. 43. 44. 45. & 49 are 120 ft long & 60 ft broad No 39 is 92 1/2 feet on the West 120 ft on the North 33 feet on the East & 121 1/2 feet on the South. Lot 45 is 70 ft on the South No 44 is 39 1/2 ft on the North. 46 is 92 ft on the South 120 on the West 150 1/2 feet.

In Consideration of the sum of fifty one dollars and sixty one cents in hand paid by William S. Haughey and Francis Daugherty and in consideration of their being my bail to one Moses Chapman on two notes of hand given by me as principal and by them as my bail to said Chapman on the 21st day of February A.D. 1843 one being for fifty dollars with interest and payable on or before the 1st day of September next and the other for fifty dollars and interest and payable on or before the 1st day of March A.D. 1844 I have bargained and sold and do hereby sell and convey to said William S. Haughey and Francis Daugherty the goods and chattels and personal property following to wit one Bay horse aged about some years and one Bay mare aged about nine years and one set of English harness (nearly new) and one (nearly new) two horse Wagon. Provided always and these presents are upon these conditions that whereas the said Christian Mungier is indebted to the said William S. Haughey in the sum of fifty dollars payable on or before the 1st day of September next with interest from date by note of even date herewith and whereas the said Christian Mungier is indebted to the said Francis Daugherty in the sum of one dollar and sixty one cents
