

George P. Sielsberger's Addition to Holmesville, Holmes Co.



I do hereby certify that the above is a correct plat and notes of George P. Sielsberger's addition of lots to the town Plat of Holmesville in Holmes County Ohio. Size of the lots are 63 feet in front & 126 feet back except Lots Nos 74, 75, & 76, which are 33 feet in front & 126 feet back. The above plat of lots are situated on the North East part of the South West quarter of Section three in Township 13 of Range 13. The numbers of the above lots commence in progressive numbers with that part of said town formerly laid out by Lockhart, Dorland & Rogers, and named Lafayette a stone planted at corner marked A, fifteen inches in diameter to mark future surveys from; said corner being the North East corner of the above described Quarter Section Kutchinsky's Lot No. 58 (above) excluded.
