This Matter this 13th day of November 1893 came on for further hearing Pursuant to the order made by this Board September 6th 1893 with the full board present and it being established to the satisfaction of this board for public hearing by evidence that the incorporated Village of Holmesville Ohio through its Council duly passed an ordinance by unanimous vote thereof authorizing the annexation to said Village the territory in the petition described, that said village by said ordinance authorized its Solicitor to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation. That the petition herein was presented to this board at its regular September Session 1893 and was duly filed in the Office of the Auditor of said County that said petition sets forth that under said Ordinance passed by said Village as afore said the territory in said petition described was authorized to be annexed to said Village, that the petition contains an accurate description of said Territory that said petition is accompanied by an accurate map or plat of said Territory, that said petition is signed by the persons authorized by said ordinance to prosecute the proceedings for the annexation of said Territory to said Village that Notices containing the substance of the Petition and the time and place of this hearing was published in the Holmes County Farmer a Newspaper printed and of a general circulation in said Holmes County for a period of six consecutive weeks prior to this hearing and commencing in the issue of said paper on the 21st day of September 1893, that copies of said Notices were posted on each of the several tracts proposed to be annexed to said Village on the 23rd day of September 1893, the same being no less than six weeks prior to this hearing and that all necessary steps in this matter have been properly taken and said board of Commissioners coming now to pass upon the merits of this Matter from the testimony find that the petition contains all the matter required by the Statute in such case that the statements of the petition are true that the limits of each of said tracts proposed to be annexed to said village are accurately described and are not in either tract unreasonably large or small that the map or plat accompanying said petition and bounding the two several tracts proposed to be annexed is accurate, that the persons whose names is subscribed to said petition was duly authorized in the premises by said village, that Notice has been given as required that it is right and proper that the prayer of said petition be granted it is therefore on this 13th day of November 1893 ordered by the Board that the territory described in said petition be and the same is hereby annexed to said incorporated Village of Holmesville and made thereof a part of said Village as prayed for in the petition that the Auditor enter all the findings and orders made by the Board in this matter upon the Journal and cause a transcript thereof together with the petition and map to be forwarded to the Clerk of said incorporated village

Resolutions A-2 and Ordinance A-16.

Resolutions accepting the annexation of certain Territory to the Village of Holmesville Ohio. Whereas on the 6th day of September 1893 the same being at a regular Session of the Board of County Commissioners of Holmes County Ohio. A Petition was presented to said Board accompanied by an accurate map or plot of certain territory in said petition described praying for the annexation of said Territory to said Village and whereas said proceedings were had by said Board of Commissioners on the 13th day of November 1893 upon said petition, map and papers after due Notice that the prayer of said petition was granted and a final transcript of the proceedings had before said Commissioners in said Matter together with said map were filed in the Office of the Clerk of said Village of Holmesville on the 16th day of November 1893 and whereas 60 days having expired since the filing of said papers with said Clerk and this being the next regular Session of the Council of said Village after the expiration of said time said Clerk having at this time laid before said Council said transcript of the proceedings had before said Commissioners together with said petition and map its consideration and acceptance.

Therefore be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Holmesville Ohio, that the application for the annexation of certain Territory to said Village as described in the petition aforesaid and plot of the same be and the same is hereby annexed to said incorporated Village for all the uses and purposes of the same, Passed by a unanimous Vote of the Council at the Council Chamber this the 23rd day of January A.D. 1894.

Now, I, John Crocker Clerk of the Village of Holmesville Ohio do hereby certify that the foregoing Resolutions A-2 and Ordinance A-16 was duly published by posting Copies thereof at five of the most public places within the incorporated limits of said Village as follows to wit: One at R. F. Staut's Store, one at Mill Halls Barber Shop, one at Miller Brothers Store, one at B. F. Woods Store front at the Post Office front and one at the front window shutter of Jasper Paulson's old Saloon Billiard and Pool Hall Rooms at each of the above Public Places one at each place for the period of fifteen days beginning on the 23rd day of January 1894.
