
In the matter of the application of the Incorporated Village of Holmesville to annex the Homestead addition on Jan 1st to said Village. The Incorporated Village of Holmesville, Holmes County, Ohio, for its application hereto says that at a regular meeting of the Council of said Village the Council duly passed an ordinance by more than a majority of the members elected to said Council authorizing of the Homestead addition to said Village to be made; said addition being situate immediately East of and contiguous to the territory of the said Village; and that said ordinance authorized, Charles R. Cary, Solicitor of the said Village to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect the Annexation of said Homestead addition to said Village.

Your petitioner further says that the above territory to be annexed is situate in the North East part of the South East quarter of Section 3, Township 13, Range 13, Prairie Township, Holmes County, Ohio, being within the bounds as follows; Starting on the East line of the right of way of the Cleveland, Akron and Cincinnati Railway Company at a point in said quarter section in the middle of the public road leading from Holmesville to Benton, Ohio; thence South 88 degrees East 1350 feet to a point in the center of the said Benton road South of the South East corner of Lot No. 1, as marked on the Plat "Exhibit A"; thence North parallel with the East line of Lot No. 1 on said Plat 1300 feet to the center of the public road leading from Holmesville to Frederickburg, Ohio, thence West along the center of the said Frederickburg road 750 feet to the right of way of the said Cleveland, Akron and Cincinnati Railway Company; thence in a South westerly direction along the East line of the said railway right of way 1400 feet to the place of beginning. There is attached hereto an accurate plat of the said Homestead addition which is marked "Exhibit A"; and said plat was duly recorded May 6th 1909 in the Plat Book of Holmes County, Ohio, Recorder's office. There resides within said Homestead addition 17 inhabitants, and name of said addition shall be the Homestead addition of the Incorporated Village of Holmesville, Holmes County, Ohio. Therefore your petitioner prays that the said Homestead addition shall be included and made part of the said Incorporated Village of Holmesville, Holmes County, Ohio, and for such other orders as the nature of this action demands.

In the matter of the application of the Incorporated Village of Holmesville to Annex this Homestead addition on in Lots to said Village. This day this cause came on for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners of Holmes County Ohio and the said Board of Commissioners find that due and legal Notice has been given for six weeks or more according to said in the Holmes County form of the pending of this application and that upon the application of said Village and the evidence, said Commissioners find that the limits of the proposed Annexation are accurately described and are not unreasonable large or small; that the Map or Plat is accurate; that Notice has been given as required by law and that it seems right and just that the prayer of the Petition be granted insofar as the Homestead addition is outlined by said Plat; to wit: Beginning at the East line of the right of way of the Cleveland, Akron and Cincinnati Railway Company at a point in the North East part of the South East quarter of Section 3 Town-ship 13 Range 13 Prairie Township, Holmes County, Ohio, in the middle of the public road leading from Holmesville to Benton, Ohio; Thence South 88 degrees East 1350 feet to a point in the center of said road South of the South East corner of Lot No. 1 as marked on the Plat of Homestead addition and recorded on the Plat Record of Holmes County, Ohio May 6th 1909; Thence North parallel with the East line of said Lot No. 1 on said Plat to a Pin at the North East corner of Lot No. 80 on said Plat; Thence East along the North line of said Lot No. 80 to 96, inclusive to the North West corner of Lot No. 96 at the right of way of the said C. A. & C. Ry. Co. Thence Southwesterly along the East side of the right of way of said Railway Company to the place of beginning; the same being the accurate description of said Homestead addition as recorded in the records office of Holmes County, Ohio Plat record, Vol-1.

The said Board of Commissioners further find that the Auditor shall cause a certified transcript of these proceedings to be delivered together with the Petition Map and all other papers on file relating to the matter to the Recorder of Holmes County Ohio at the earliest time practicable.
