SECTION 15, T^p 8, R. 7, HOLMES COUNTY, OHIO.

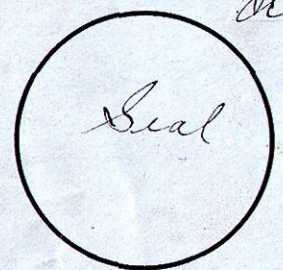
