

Description of Eastern Boundary line

of Territory Annexed to the Incorporation of the Village of Killbuck Ohio, commencing in the center of Killbuck Creek 40 Perches South of a Stone at the North west Corner of the North west quarter of Section 15, Tp 8, R 4, and 125 feet west of a Stone on the said quarter section, on the lands of E. & J. Carpenter: Thence S. 84° E. 1025 feet to a post on the west line of the Dresden Branch of the Cleveland Akron & Columbus Rail Road; Thence S. 84° E. across said Rail Road, and the Public Road 550 feet to a Stone; Thence N. 4° E. 652 feet to a post on the west line of the grave yard; Thence N. 4° E. 920 feet to a post on the line between J. E. Pomeroy and Mr. C. Maltman. Thence N. 4° E. 1000 feet to the line between lands of J. E. Pomeroy and J. C. & M. Pomeroy; Thence N. 40° west along said line 137 feet to a Stone on the East line of the Dresden Branch of the E. A. & C. R. R. Thence N. 13° E. along said East line 585 feet to a post; Thence N. 24° E. along said East line 500 feet to a post on the South line of the Public Road; Thence N. 64° E. along the South line of said Road, 995 feet to a post; Thence N. 60° E. along said South line 200 feet to a Stone on the line between Pomeroy & Maltman. Thence N. 4° E. along said line 121 feet to the South line of the Cleveland Akron & Columbus R. R. Thence N. 4° E. across said Rail Road, 261 feet to the center of Killbuck Creek Thence in a southerly direction along the center of said creek and with the meandering thereof to the place of beginning.
