
## PLAT SHOWING ANNEXATION TO KILLBUCK

## PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

We, the undersigned, being a majority of the adult freeholders residing on the following described territory, situated in the County of Holmes and adjacent to the Village of Killbuck, to wit:

Being a part of the middle part of Section 15, Township 8, Range 7, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at a stone monument located at the intersection of the south corporation line of the Village of Killbuck and the west property line of the Dresden Branch Railroad; thence south 89° 45' west along the adjacent corporation line 40 feet to the place of beginning of the tract of land herein described; thence along said corporation line 580.7 feet; thence south 2° 45' east 226 feet; thence north 89° 45' east 193 feet; thence north 2° 45' west 76 feet; thence north 89° 45' east 387.7 feet; thence north 2° 45' west 150 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.32 acres, more or less, but subject to the right of way of the public highway.

(See plat hereto attached on which the above described premises are divided into seven tracts being a one acre tract and six lots numbered from 1 to 6.)

respectfully petition that the said above described territory may be annexed to the Village of Killbuck.

## ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS FOR ANNEXATION

The Commissioners of the County of Holmes, State of Ohio, proceeding this day to hear the petition of Bessie Carpenter and others to obtain the annexation of the territory in their petition described to the Village of Killbuck, and having in open meeting heard all the persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition and being fully advised, find that said petition contains all the matters required by law, that its statements are true, that the territory sought to be ammexed is adjacent to the said Village of Killbuck, that the petition contains a full description of said territory, that he map of said territory attached to the petition is accurate, that said petition is signed by a majority of the adult free-holders residing on the territory sought to be annexed, that the required legal notice of the petition has been granted, and that it is right and proper that said petition should be granted.

It is hereby ordered that the prayer of said petition be granted and that the territory described in said petition may be annexed to the Village of Killbuck in accordance with law and that a certified transcript signed by a majority of this Board, of all the orders and proceedings of this Board relative to said petition and hearings thereon, together with said petition and may be attached thereto, and all the papers on file relating to said matter, be deposited at once with the Clerk of the Council of said Village of Killbuck.

ORDINANCE NO. 183

ACCEPTING APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY
BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Killbuck, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the application of Bessie Carpenter and others for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Holmes and adjacent to the Village of Killbuck, to wit:

"Being a part of the middle part of Section 15, Township 8, Range 7, bounded and described as follows:
