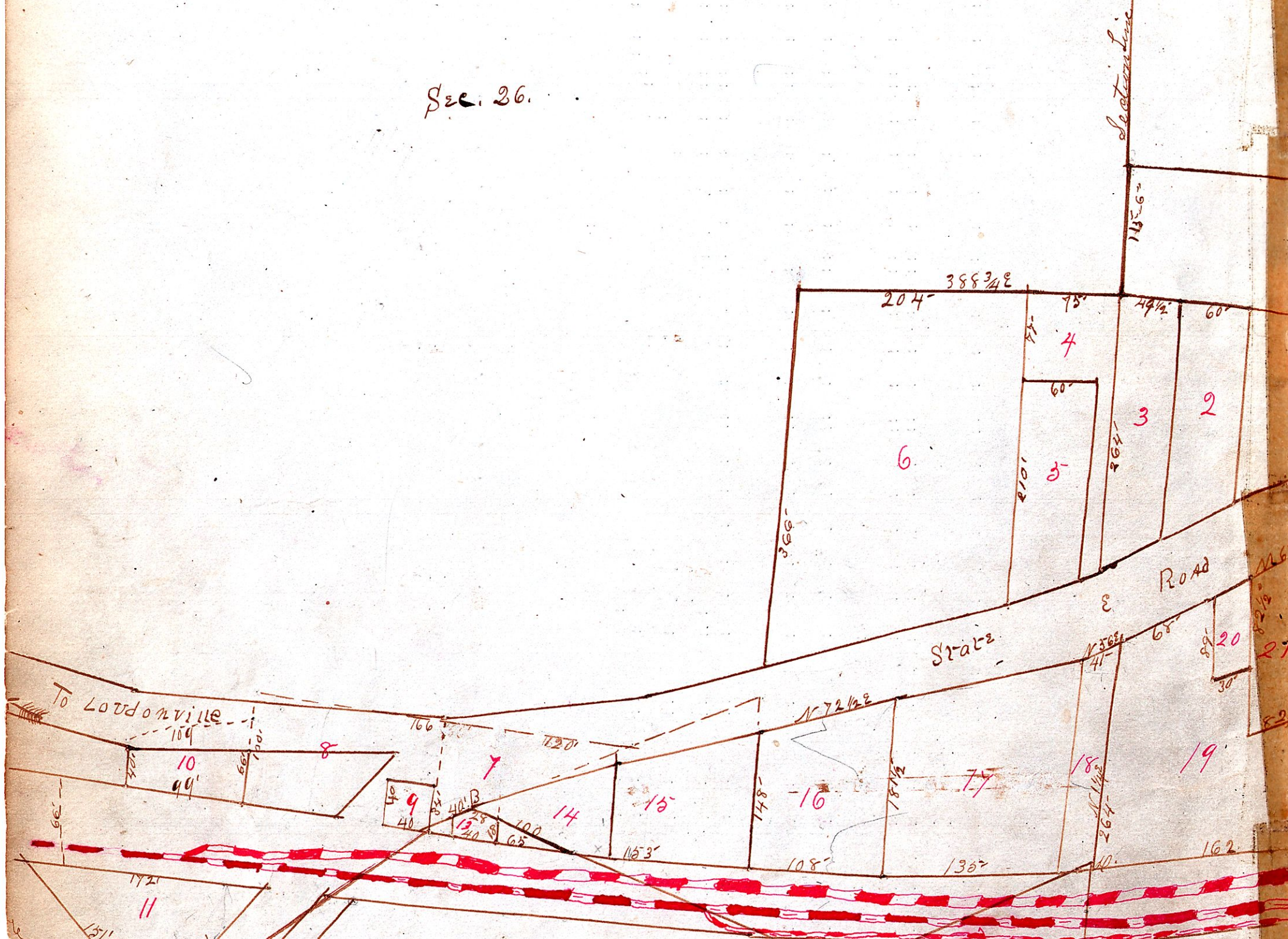


# LAKEVILLE

 Station 12  
 "A" is Station 18 of the Shearer Mill privilege and from "A" N 52° 22' 46 3/4" E 463 ch to "B".  
 "B" is Station 17 of the Shearer Mill privilege and from "B" S 70° 1/2' E 2,530 ch to "C". "C" is station 16 of the Shearer Mill privilege and from "C" N 64° 1/2' E 3-11 ch to "D". From "D" north to "E" is 12-47 ch and from "E" south to the center of the railway is 4,000 ch. From "E" N 11-52 ch west and station 10 } 3-5 ch north of S.E. corner of Sec. 26, "D" is 14.90 ch north of "E", or the S.E. corner of Sec. 26. The "right of way" of the P. & N. Ry. Co. is 66 ft. Note all lots extend to the center of the State Road except where otherwise shown by dotted lines.
