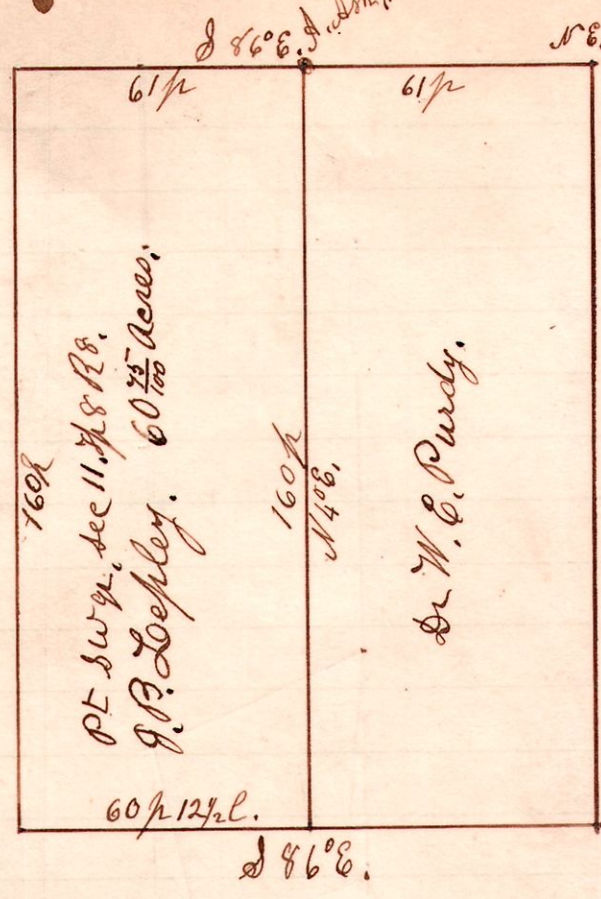


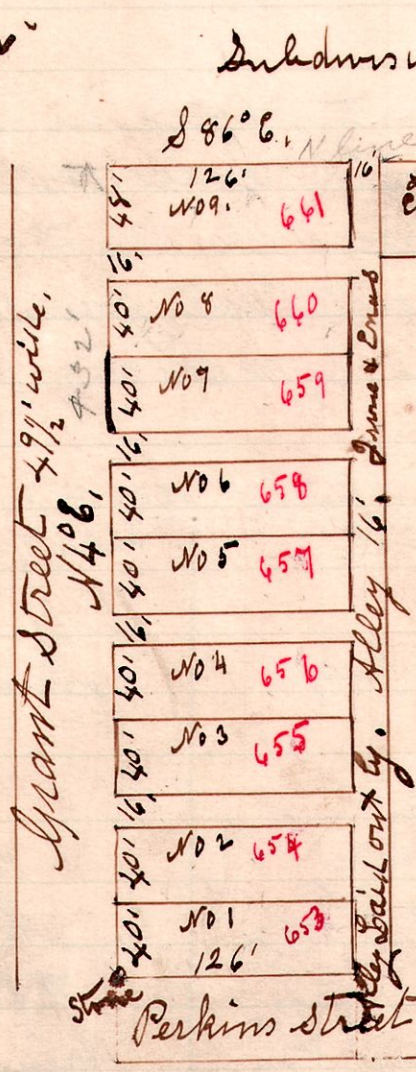

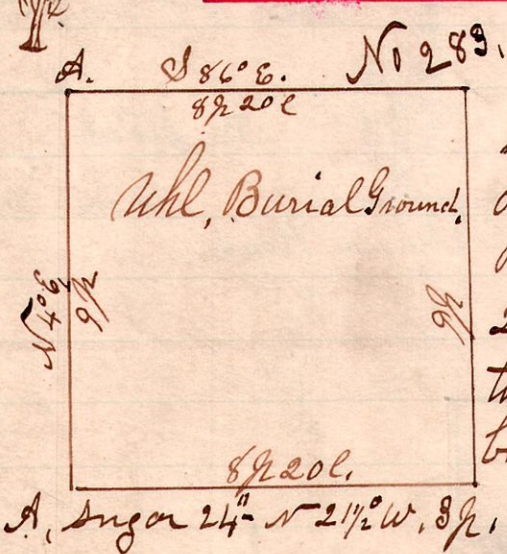

 of lot No 1, from which to make future surveys.

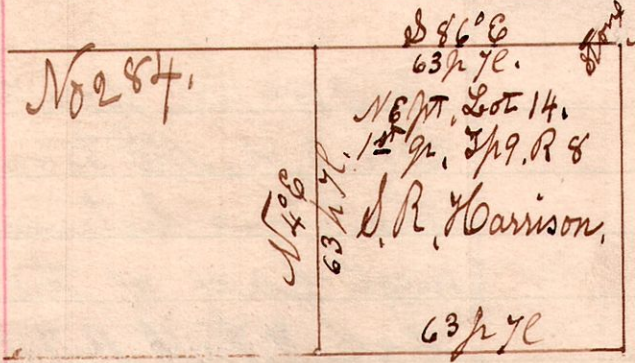
