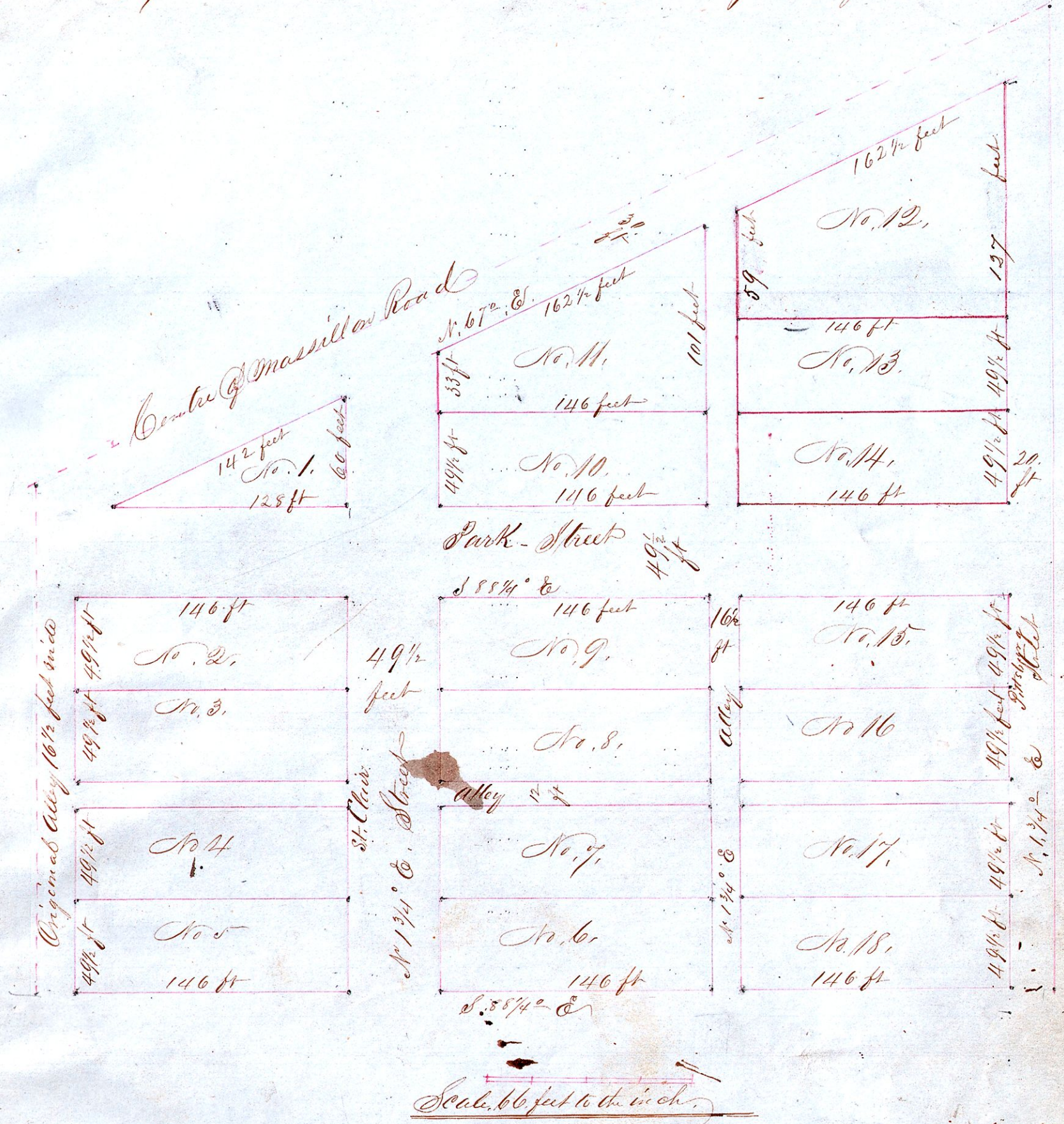


Lewis Mayer's Addition to the town of Millersburg, August 2nd 1860.



I do hereby Certify that the above is a correct plat of 18 lots, in Lewis Mayer's addition, to the original plat of 18 lots, in the town of Millersburg the County Seat of Holmes County, Ohio. The above Lots is situated on Sub-Division Oct Lot Number 42, North East of the original plat of said Millersburg. The length of the lines of said lots, the width of the streets & alleys, are marked on said plat in feet. Also the bearings of the lines are marked on said Plat, by a stone 7 inches diameter at the top, planted at the N. E. Corner of Lot No. 9, to make future surveys from.
