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The Publick Square on the above plat is sixteen perches by twelve perches Jackson street
and Clay street are each four perches wide the other streets are all three perches wide
publick alley court house alley and centre alley & Clinton alley are all sixteen feet wide
the residue of the alleys are all ten feet wide the lots are each four perches by eight
perches except what the alleys takes off situated as mented on the above plat the public
square together with the streets and alleys are donated for public use the north west corner
of the public square is hereby established as the stand and corner of said town from which
conce all lots street and alleys must be regulated April 8th 1824.
