 July A.D. 1836, and whereas the said John Baird by deed duly executed
 upon bearing date the 14th day of October A.D. 1836, granted the same to Henry
 Reider, the present grantor.

To have and to hold the said half quarter of Town with all the
 privileges, and appurtenances therein the said Daniel Schwentzentruber and
 his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Reider, doth hereby covenant
 for himself and his heirs to and with the said Daniel Schwentzentruber and
 his heirs and assigns that he the said Henry Reider, and his heirs and assigns
 quarter of Town hereby granted to the said Daniel Schwentzentruber and
 his heirs and assigns will forever warrant and defend by these presents -
