 West line of lines No 16 & 17 and the engine part of Weinsburgh the Alley running between lines
 No 39 & 40 in the above first addition is 33 feet wide the alley on the rear of Lots 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41 & 42

 and all the lots commencing at Lot 33 and terminating at Lot 47, in the above first addition is
 intended for sale the lots vary in size but the courses of each line and their distance and marked on the

 Whereas Simon Chapman of Holmes County Ohio has
 deposited in the General Land Office of the United
 States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Zanesville Ohio whereby it appears
 that full payment has been made by the said Simon Chapman according to
 the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled an act
 making further provisions for the sale of the public Lands, per the North West
 Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section 17th in Township Eight of Range
 Seven of the Unappropriated Lands, in the Military District Subject to sale at
 Zanesville Ohio Containing forty acres, according to the Official plat of
 the survey of the Lands, Returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
 General (which said tract has been purchased by the said Simon
 Chapman). Now Know Ye, that the United States of America
