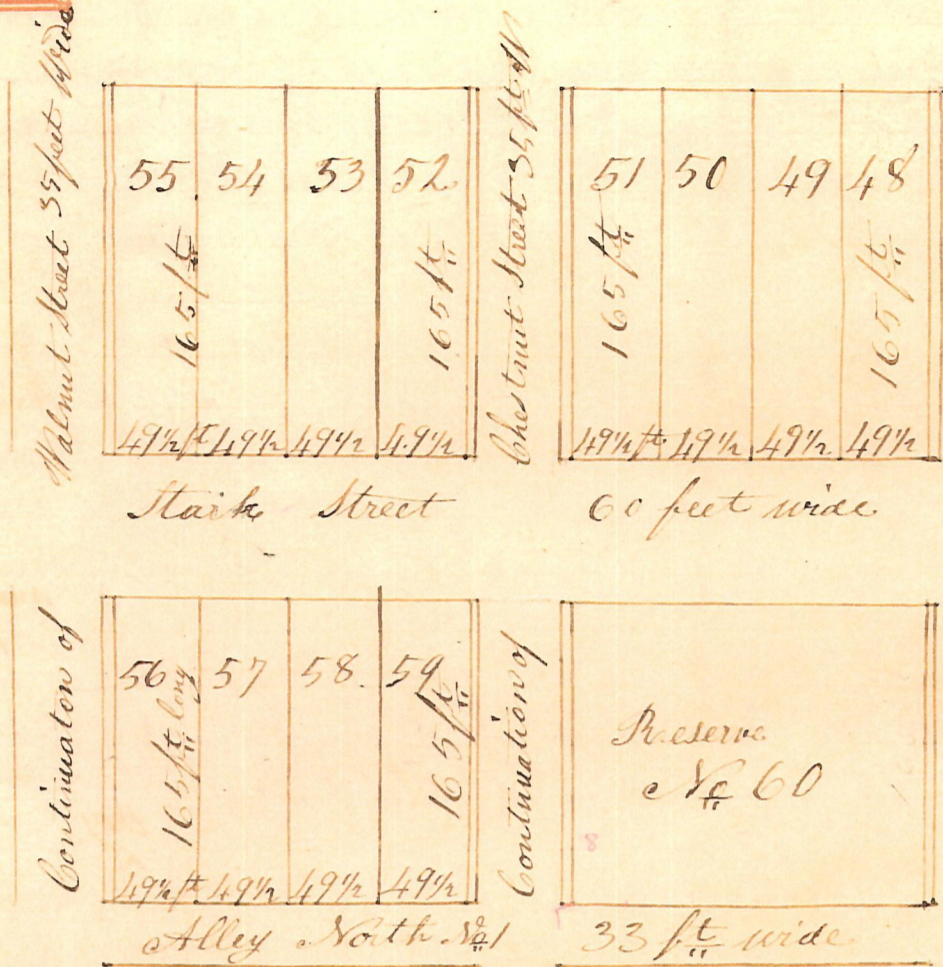


No. 2^d Addition

No. 2^d Addition of the Town of Winesburg, Surveyed August 17th 1843 commencing at the corner of the reserve No. 60 being 33 feet North of the N.W. corner of lot No. 8 in the original town plat, and running 1st N. 68^o E. 819 1/2 feet including side walks on the East & West of each block which are 5 feet wide the length and width of the lots and the width of the Streets and alleys are as marked on the above plat as surveyed for Christian Smith of Paint T. S. Holmes county Ohio on the above which certify to be correct. Anson Wheaton Surveyor Holmes Co. O.

I Christian Smith of Holmes county Ohio acknowledge hereby the laying out and surveying of the above 2^d addition of inlots to the town plat of Winesburg, that is to say commencing the corner of the reserve No. 60 terminating as in the above plat

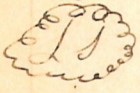
